A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MAYOR ATTY. JAIME R. FRESNEDI TO ENTER AND SIGN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) BETWEEN THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF MUNTINLUPA AND BEST SECURITY AGENCY FOR THE NEW CONTRACT OF SECURITY SERVICES IN THE AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY (AOR) FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2020, MORE SPECIFICALLY: THE MUNTINLUPA CITY PUBLIC MARKET, LOCATED AT BARANGAY ALABANG, MUNTINLUPA CITY AMOUNTING TO SIX MILLION ONE HUNDRED FIFTY-SIX THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE PESOS AND 84/100 (PHP6,156,951.84) SHALL BE TAKEN FROM THE 2020 EXECUTIVE BUDGET.

WHEREAS, Article 86 (b)(1)(vi) and Article 86 (b)(1)(viii) of the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that, **"the City Mayor shall represent the city in all its business transaction and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinances"**;

WHEREAS, Rule IX, Article 47 of the Rules and Regulations Implementing the Local Government of 1991, state that, **"xxx no contract may be entered into by the Local Government Chief Executive in behalf of the Local Government Unit without prior authorization by the Sangguniang concerned"**;

WHEREAS, Section 48. Article XVI of Republic Act No. 9184, provides that, **"in order to promote economy and efficiency, the procuring entity may resort to any of the alternative methods of procurement, which includes: Limited Source Bidding, Direct Contracting, Repeat Order, Shopping and Negotiated Procurement"**;
