WHEREAS, Section 15 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the new Local Government Code of 1991, provides that, **“every local government unit created or reorganized under this code is a body politic and corporate endowed with the powers to exercise by it in conformity with law.”**

WHEREAS, Section 22 of the same Code states that, “every local Government Unit, as a corporation, shall have the following powers:
