WHEREAS, under Section 15, Article II of the Philippines Constitution, "it is the State's policy to protect and promote the right to health of the people";

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 (LGC) provides that, "every local government unit (LGU) shall exercise powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare";

WHEREAS, in March 2020, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte issued Proclamation Nos. 922 and 929, declaring a State of Public Health Emergency and State of Calamity, respectively, throughout the Philippines to contain the spread of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) in the Philippines;

WHEREAS, on 24 March 2020, the Congress through the "Bayanihan to Heal as One Act" (R.A. No. 11469) declared a State of National Emergency over the entire country to respond efficiently to the crisis brought by the pandemic and to accentuate the urgent need to mitigate, if not contain, the transmission of COVID-19.
