WHEREAS, Article 86 (b)(1)(vi) and Article 86 (b)(1)(viii) of the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that, **"the City Mayor shall represent the city in all its business transactions and sign in its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations and such other documents upon authority of the Sangguniang Panlungsod or pursuant to law or ordinances"**;

WHEREAS, Rule IX, Article 47 of the Rules and Regulations implementing the Local Government Code of 1991, states that, **"xxx no contract may be entered into by the Local Chief Executive in behalf of the Local Government Unit without prior authorization by the Sanggunian concerned"**;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Muntinlupa (CGM), through its Drug Abuse Prevention and Control Office (DAPCO), citing the TRD-DAPCO data, registered a rate of more that Eighty-Five percent (85%) successful treatment and rehabilitation of drug dependents;

WHEREAS, the high success rate is attributed to the intervention being given to persons who use drugs (PWUDs) with low to moderate condition of drug use in Community-Based Drug Rehabilitation Program (CBDRP), the support of the various stakeholders and the allocation of funding for PWUDs' rehabilitation and treatment;
