WHEREAS, the Philippine Charity Sweepstakes Office (PCSO) was created under Philippine Legislature Act No. 4130 on October 30, 1934 and later amended by Republic Act No. 1169 in 1954 and Batas Pambansa Blg. 42 on September 24, 1979. It is the principal government agency for raising and providing funds for health programs, medical assistance and services, and charities of national character.

WHEREAS, under RA 1169, the PCSO, by authority of the Office of the President, shall dispose gross receipts from sale of tickets for races in the amount corresponding to six percent (6%) for cities to be expended for the maintenance of provincial, city and municipal hospitals, and for other health, social welfare, and charitable work in their respective jurisdiction

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 357, as amended, provides for the proportional grant of thirty percent (30%) Lotto Charity Fund in favor of local government units where lotto tickets are sold, and the city is authorized to receive its share of the Lotto Charity Fund in the amount corresponding to five (5%) percent."

WHEREAS, Section 22 of the same Code states that, "every local Government Unit, as a corporation, shall have the following powers:
