**WHEREAS**, on April 20, 2006 the City Development Council approved Resolution No. 01-06, "providing for the approval of the utilization of twenty percent 20% community Development Fund of the City of Muntinlupa for Calendar Year 2006";

**WHEREAS**, Atty. Henry Reyes, City Administrator, has submitted to the City Council the City Development Council (CDC) Resolution No. 01-06 providing for the approval of the utilization of twenty percent (20%) Community Development Fund (CDF) of the City of Muntinlupa for Calendar Year 2006;

**WHEREAS**, there is available funding for the calendar year 2006 coming from the twenty percent (20%) of the city's share from the Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) in the total amount of Php78,000,000.00;

**WHEREAS**, the city has enumerated the different projects and activities to ensure the utmost effectiveness in responding to the felt needs of the people of Muntinlupa;

**WHEREAS**, all development projects for the calendar year 2006 to be funded from 20% share of the IRA are the following:

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## II. TO BE APPROPRIATED AS FOLLOWS:

## A. SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT

53,445,000.00

1. Establishment or rehabilitation of Productivity Enhancement Center for out-of-school youths, women, minors, displaced families, indigenous people, differently-abled persons and older persons:

## - SAGIP

400,000.00

This Family Crisis Center has been established to take care, assist and intervene cases of children and women who are victims of maltreatment, harassment, rape and other forms of physical and mental abuse.

## - Social Development Center for Street Children

500,000.00

The local government through the SDC continuously shares its commitment in providing street children the opportunities, resources, training, rehabilitative and spiritual services to become better citizens of the society.

## - Poverty Alleviation Program

5,000,000.00

Poverty in the City means a survival issue, both on the poor individual or family on one side and the local government on the other side. While the poor families have increased "unmet basic needs" like food, shelter and education, the government on the other hand, has only limited resources. When this happens, there is an increased demand by poor communities for basic services from the government. At the same time, there is also an increased need by the local government for more resource allocations to deliver the basic services. Thus, adequate allocations must be addressed.

## - Assistance to Informal Dwellers (e.g. relocation)

500,000.00

As part of city's initiatives to promote the welfare of priority depressed areas (PDAs), informal settlers receive assistance during relocation by providing them temporary shelter, sufficient food, and other assistance that concern their living.

## 2. Support/ Assistance for the operation of Muntinlupa City Technical Institute

1,929,300.00

- Construction/Operation of Muntinlupa City Technical Institute  
This will enhance more the capacity of individuals who are inclined to technical/ vocational skills by providing a conducive learning and training center.



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**3. Construction or rehabilitation of health centers, rural health unit or hospital, and purchase of medical equipment:**

- **Purchase of medicines, supplies and materials** **1,200,000.00**

It entails to procurement of mostly prescribed medicines on preventive and curative measures being undertaken by the locality under the Health Office. Also, this complements the procurement of pills and injectibles during the implementation of phase-out period from DOH.

- **Barangay Health Workers** **5,100,000.00**

This supports the Health Workers on their tasks of doing public health-related service especially to poor constituents.

**4. Preservation of Cultural/Historical Sites** **2,000,000.00**

- **Muntinlupa Historical Commission**

Being a fast rising urban center, the City still preserves its historical heritage for tourist attraction. The MHC will handle the launching and reproduction of a book which shall serve as factual documentation featuring the basic profile of the City, the notable accomplishments of the current administration, and other significant scenarios for Muntinlupa.

**5. Other Programs or Projects:** **36,815,700.00**

- **Migration Information Center** **300,000.00**

The MIC facilitates the monitoring of influx of migrants in the City. Such mechanism allows the gathering of data and determines the characteristics of the new migrants and assists them with information needs and basic services and facilities available at each Barangay and City level as a whole.

- **City Pound** **500,000.00**

This supports the initiative of the local government to free Muntinlupa from stray dogs. The city animal pound is in full operation and must provide at least two (2) roaming impounding vehicles around the City.



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- **Iskolar ng Bayan** **7,256,000.00**  
The program provides poor and yet deserving students enrolled in Pamantasan ng Lungsod ng Muntinlupa (PLMun) with free college education and monthly allowances.
- **Publication of Lingkod Bayan** **2,000,000.00**  
Maintains the weekly publication of the newsletter-material by the Public Information Office to convey latest news and events occurring in the vicinity of the local government and all corners of the City.
- **Reproduction of City Profiles/ Brochures/ Info Materials** **1,450,000.00**  
Provide well-packaged information materials highlighting the programs and projects of the local government; promotes Muntinlupa as a competitive city; and provides vital information on researchers, academe, business sector, and other agencies which have queries on the socio-economic profile of the City.
- **Purchase of Light Duty Truck for community service** **2,468,600.00**  
This will address various requests of the community on transportation of goods and services.
- **Master Planning for the City of Muntinlupa** **100,000.00**  
Serve as blueprint of development for the City.
- **City Development Strategy** **500,000.00**  
This conforms to the development strategies being undertaken by the locality as a competitive and highly-urbanized city in the country which is manifested on its dynamic participation on the League of Cities of the Philippines.
- **City Library** **500,000.00**  
Caters the needs of students and researchers to access wide range of books and modern computer facilities and services.

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- **Barangay Development Council Consultation** 200,000.00  
This is an institutional activity that has been created to guide the Barangay officials on their development plans.
- **Training for officials and employees** 1,650,000.00  
Provide opportunities to officials and employees to enhance their technical know-how, and to help enrich as well their morale as government people
- **Computerization Program**
- **City comprehensive computerization program** 1,000,000.00  
Computerization of government operations contributed greatly to the success of prompt and effective service, and ensures as well, a systematic flow of income collection.
- **Geographic Information System** 1,100,000.00  
Special type of information system done through computer programming concerned with the representation and manipulation of a model of geographic reality. GIS is an effective management tool for planners and decision-makers.
- **Construction of Covered Courts** 17,791,100.00  
This will fund various requests from the community/ homeowner's association for provision of covered courts on their respective villages/ places.

**B. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT** 9,287,050.00

Implementation of a livelihood/ entrepreneurship development program or project

- **Joint Resources for Family Program** 5,187,050.00  
The JRF Program strengthen the relationship of families through providing possible resources that will help meet the demands of living.
- **Loan Assistance** 4,000,000.00  
Provide loan opportunities for poor but business-oriented constituents.



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- **Cooperative Consultation, Computerization** 100,000.00  
Acquisition of Training Equipment  
Strengthen the existence of Cooperative Office through restructuring of office system and physical facilities.

**C. ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT** 15,267,950.00

- **Solid Waste Management** 1,500,000.00  
Address various issues on comprehensive developmental plan for solid waste system including but not limited to garbage collection and disposal
- **Land Banking / Land Acquisition and other** 13,767,950.00  
Government Projects (Land Filling of Low Lying Areas)


