ORDINANCE NO. 08-042

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 98-008, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE "ISKOLAR NG BAYAN ORDINANCE" PROVIDING ADDITIONAL INCENTIVES TO THE SCHOLARS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Articles 14, Sec. 1 of the 1987 Constitution provides for the protection and promotion of the right of all citizens to quality education at all levels and shall take appropriate steps to make such education accessible to all;

WHEREAS, pursuant to R.A. 7160 (5) (xi), the City Council has created the "Iskolar ng Bayan" program providing free college education at the Muntinlupa Polytechnic College now known as the Pamantasan ng Lungsod ng Muntinlupa (PLMUN) for the poor but deserving students of Muntinlupa;

WHEREAS, the "Iskolar ng Bayan" program which took effect on June still needs to be strengthened by providing additional incentives to poor but deserving students;

WHEREAS, the City Council unanimously decided to grant a "Free Graduate Studies for deserving Teachers at the Pamantasan ng Lungsod ng Muntinlupa in addition to the foregoing;

WHEREAS, the rationale behind these amendments is to provide graduates of public high school in Muntinlupa wider access and opportunity to collegiate education being one of the priorities of the current dispensation;

WHEREAS, it has been noted that in the past several years, there is an alarming increase in the number of high school graduates who cannot afford to pursue college education due to acute financial constraints;

WHEREAS, in addition to the foregoing, the package of scholarship grants shall now include "Free Graduate Studies" for deserving Teachers as well, to be offered exclusively at the Pamantasan ng Lungsod ng Muntinlupa;

WHEREAS, the current dispensation believes that quality education does not only refer to the educational development of the students alone but it also entails the career development of the mentors as well;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained as it is hereby ordained, by the 5th Sangguniang Panglungsod of Muntinlupa in session assembled the following;

Section 1. Title – this Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 98-008, otherwise known as the "Iskolar ng Bayan Program" providing for additional incentives to the scholars and for other purposes.

A.) "Iskolar ng Bayan" – Pamantasan ng Lungsod ng Muntinlupa (PLMUN)

Target beneficiaries – incoming first (1st) year students who

are fresh graduates of Public High schools in Muntinlupa; it shall likewise include fresh graduates of private schools if and only if vacancy occurs, wherein the slots reserved for graduates of public schools remain untaken, there are available funds and the class size per course is in accord with PLMUN standards;

a.1. Qualifications;

a.1.1. First Coverage: First (1st) year studies only;

- Recipients and parents are residents and registered voters of Muntinlupa (with Barangay Certification and Voters ID);
- Graduates of the Public High Schools of Muntinlupa;
- Shall take a profiling, fitting- in and placement examination according to PLMUN standards;
- Form 137 and certificate of Good Moral Character;
- ITR/Sworn Statement of non-payment;

a.1.2. Second Coverage: Second to Fourth year (2nd – 4th) studies only;

- General weighted average of at least 85%
- with no failing grade in the first year of studies as the case may be;
- with no dropped subject in first year of studies as the case may be;
- with no incomplete grade in first year of studies as the case may be;

a.2 Benefits;

First Coverage: First (1st) year studies only;

- Free matriculation fees;

Second Coverage: Second to Fourth year (2nd – 4th) studies only;

- Free matriculation fees per semester (exclusive of miscellaneous fees);
- ₱ 1,000.00 book allowance per semester;
- ₱ 1,000.00 uniform allowance per semester;
- ₱ 1,000.00 transportation allowance per semester;

a.3. Execution of a Memorandum of Agreement between the City Government and the student – beneficiary:

- Individual Memoranda of Agreements between the City Government of Muntinlupa and the beneficiaries of Collegiate Studies;
- After completion of the Collegiate scholarship degree, the beneficiary shall render two (2) years of service to the City of Muntinlupa, to be determined by the Scholar and approved by the Muntinlupa Scholarship Foundation;
- An adhoc Committee is hereby created Chaired by the Assistant City Schools District Superintendent of the Department of Education for the drafting of the Memorandum of Agreement between the City Mayor and the Scholar;

B). "Iskolar ng Bayan" – Pamantasan ng Lungsod ng Muntinlupa (PLMUN)
Target beneficiaries – Public Elementary and High School Teachers, currently teaching at Public Elementary and High schools in Muntinlupa City;

b.1. Qualifications;

- Residents and registered voters of Muntinlupa;
- Graduate of a Bachelors Degree Course;
- Minimum of five (5) years teaching experience;
- Fully accomplished "Permit to Study";
- VS Performance Rating for the last three (3) years;

b.2. Target Beneficiaries distributed as follows:

b.2.1. Elementary Teachers:

- 5 teachers each from MES, AES, SES;
- 2 teachers each from IES, TES, PES, SHES, CES, BES, Unit I B-Main,
- 1 teacher each from F. De mesa, LES, BSES, CESA, Victoria;

b.2.2 High School Teachers:

- 5 teachers each from MNHS, PEDHS;
- 2 teachers each from MBHS, MSHS;

b.3. Benefits;

- Free matriculation fees for graduate studies at the PLMUN;

b.4. Execution of a Memorandum of Agreement between the City Government and the teacher - beneficiary;

- Individual Memoranda of Agreements between the City Government of Muntinlupa and the beneficiaries of Graduate Studies;
- After completion of the Masteral of Arts (M.A.) scholarship degree, the beneficiary shall render two (2) years of service to the City of Muntinlupa for every year of scholarship granted to the beneficiary;
- An adhoc Committee is hereby created Chaired by the Assistant City Schools District Superintendent of the Department of Education for the drafting of the Memorandum of Agreement between the City Mayor and the Scholar;

C. Financial Assistance to Elementary and High Schools Students

Target beneficiaries - Thirty (30) students per school, both for Elementary and High School;

c.1. Qualifications:

- Recipients and parents are registered voters of Muntinlupa City;

- Recommendation from the Adviser and Guidance Counselor of the school;
- Approval of the Principal;
- ITR/Affidavit of Non-payment;
- No grade below 80%;

c.2. Benefits:

- The grantee is entitled to;
 - Elementary – ₱ 200 monthly allowance;
 - Secondary – ₱ 300 monthly allowance;

D. Financial Assistance to scholars of other Colleges and Universities:

Target Beneficiaries: Sixty (60) regular scholars;

- Students as certified, belonging to the Top ten percent of the graduating class in the Private Schools;
- Students as certified, belonging to the Top twenty percent of the graduating class in the Public Schools;
- Must have a general weighted average of at least 85%;
- After assessment including the result of the qualifying examination, applicants shall be ranked. Those belonging to the Top sixty (60) percent shall be eligible for the scholarship program;

d.1. Benefits:

- The grantee is entitled to;
 - A maximum of Thirty Thousand Pesos (Php 30,000.00) as full scholar per semester/tri-semester/quarter term which includes:
 - Tuition fees;
 - Transportation allowance;
 - Uniform allowance;
 - Book allowance;
 - A maximum of Fifteen Thousand Pesos (Php 15,000.00) as half scholar per semester/tri-semester/quarter term which includes:
 - Tuition fees;
 - Transportation allowance;
 - Uniform allowance;
 - Book allowance;

d.2. Conditions:

- The grantee must maintain an average grade of ;
 - 1.0 – 2.00 for full scholarship;
 - 2.01 – 2.25 for half scholarship;

d.3 Execution of a Memorandum of Agreement between the City Government and the student – beneficiary:

- Individual Memoranda of Agreements between the City Government of Muntinlupa and the beneficiaries of Collegiate Studies;
- After completion of the Collegiate scholarship degree, the beneficiary shall render two (2) years of service to the City of Muntinlupa, to be determined by the Scholar and approved by the Muntinlupa Scholarship Foundation;
- An adhoc Committee is hereby created Chaired by the Assistant City Schools District Superintendent of the Department of Education for the drafting of the Memorandum of Agreement for ratification by the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Muntinlupa;

Section 2. Scholarship Committee. A "Scholarship Committee" is hereby created composed of the Dean of the Pamantasan ng Lungsod ng Muntinlupa as Chairman and the School Registrar, a representative from the Mayor's Office, a representative from the Sangguniang Panlungsod, and the City School Division Superintendent, as members to screen qualified applicants.

Section 3. Appropriation. The Budget shall be taken from the 2008 Executive Budget under Social Development – Other Programs and Projects and income derived from the collection of fees from the Alabang City Terminal.

Section 4. Separability Clause. If from any reason whatsoever, any section, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or inconsistent with any national law, other sections, clauses or provisions hereof which are not hereby affected, shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 5. Repealing Clause – All Ordinances or provisions thereof contrary to this Ordinance are deemed modified, repealed, and/or modified accordingly.
