ORDINANCE NO. 18-184

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE LOCAL YOUTH DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MUNTINLUPA, DEFINING ITS OBJECTIVES, FUNCTIONS, COMPOSITIONS AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES. **** Sponsored by: Hon. WHEREAS, Section 23 of Republic Act No. 10742 mandates the creation of Local Youth Development Council (LYDC) in every city, municipality and province;

WHEREAS, the creation of Local Youth Development Council will be the enabling mechanism for meaningful youth participation through the mutual coordination of the Local Development Council (LYDC) and the Sangguniang Kabataan in the City of Muntinlupa;

NOW BE IT ORDAINED, AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED, by the 8th Sangguniang Panlungsod of Muntinlupa, in Session assembled that:

SECTION 1. *Title* – this ordinance shall be known as, "an ordinance creating the Local Youth Development Council of the City of Muntinlupa, defining its objectives, functions, compositions and appropriate funds thereof and for other purposes.

SECTION 2. *Declaration of Policy* – It is the declared policy of the City of Muntinlupa to recognize vital role of the youth in the nation-building to promote and protect the physical, moral, spiritual and intellectual and social well-being of Filipino Youth, inculcating in them patriotism and nationalism and encourage their involvement in public and civil affairs.

SECTION 3. *Definition of Terms* - As used in this ordinance, the following terms shall mean:







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- a. **Youth** refers to those persons whose age ranges from fifteen (15)⁴to thirty (30) years as provided under Republic Act No. 8044.
- b. **In-School-Youth** refers to youth attending either formal or non-school based educational programs under institutions recognized by state.
- c. Out-of-School Youth refers to youth not enrolled in any formal or vocational school, not employed or self employed and are not college or technical/vocational school graduates.
- d. Working Youth refers to youth who are either employed, self employed, underemployed or belong to specific employable job seeking youth groups (such as graduates or tertiary or vocational schools, or those who previously were employed and actively looking for work) both in the formal and informal sectors of the society.
- e. **Youth with Special Needs** refers to youth marginalized by existing societal forces namely: youth in indigenous cultural communities, youth with disabilities, youth in situations of armed conflict, victims of natural disasters and calamities, youth offenders, delinquent youth, street youth, and abandoned/neglected youth.
- f. Local Youth Development Office shall refer to the youth office in every local government unit headed by a local youth development officer whether appointed or designated by the local chief executive.
- g. Commission shall refer to the National Youth Commission created under Republic Act No. 8044;
- Local Chief Executive shall refer to the provincial governor, city and municipal mayor;
- i. Local Government Operations Officer shall refer to the duly designated head of the office of the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) stationed in the concerned local government unit.
- j. **Sangguniang Panlungsod** refers to the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Muntinlupa as the legislative body of the local government unit.
- k. **Youth Organizations** shall refer to those organizations whose membership/composition are the youth and
 - **Youth Serving Organizations** shall refer to those registered organizations whose principal programs, projects and activities are youth-oriented and youth released.





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SECTION 4. Local Youth Development Council – There shall be a created Local Youth Development Council in every city which shall be responsible for the formulation of policies and implementation of youth development programs, projects and activities in coordination with various government and non-government organizations.

SECTION 5. Objectives - Local Youth Development Council shall have the following objectives.

General Objectives:

- a. To develop and harness the full potential of the youth as responsible partners in nation-building.
- b. To encourage intensive and active participation of youth in all government non-government programs, projects and activities affecting them.
- c. To harmonize all government and non-government initiatives for the development of the youth sector, and
- d. To supplement government appropriations for youth promotion and development with funds from other sources.

Specific Objectives:

- a. To broaden and strengthen the service provided by the national government agencies, local government units, and private agencies to young people.
- b. To provide information mechanism on youth opportunities on the areas of education, employment, livelihood, physical and mental health capability and networking.
- c. To increase the spirit of volunteerism among the youth in City of Muntinlupa particularly the maintenance of peace and order and preservation, conservation, and protection of the environment and natural resources within their locality.
- d. To provide monitoring and coordinating mechanism for youth programs projects and activities, and
- e. To provide a venue for the active participation of the youth in cultural and eco-tourism awareness programs.

SECTION 6. *Composition of the Council* – The council shall be composed of a minimum number of eight (8) to a maximum of nineteen (19) members. The council composition shall be the following:





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- 2) Sangguniang Kabataan Pederasyon President Co-Chairperson
- 3) Sangguniang Kabataan Pederasyon Vice-President Member
- 4) Elected representative of student leaders from SUC Member
- 5) Elected representative of student leaders from private colleges Members
- 6) Elected representative of student leaders from Public High School Member
- 7) Elected representative of student leaders from private High School Member
- 8) Elected representative of community youth leaders from among= YORP registered organization in each barangay – Member
- 9) Two youth representative from the church-based organizations -Member
- 10) Other members of the youth sector as may be required by the council in accordance to R.A. No. 10742.

SECTION 7. *Function of the Local Youth Development Council* – The following shall be the functions of the Local Youth Development Council:

- a) To formulate policies and component programs in coordination with the various government agencies handling youth-related programs, projects and activities.
- b) To coordinate and harmonize activities of all agencies and organizations in the City of Muntinlupa engaged in youth development programs.
- c) To develop and provide support for the development and coordination of youth projects and designed strategies to gain support and participation of the youth.
- d) To accredit sports and recreational centers, hostels, training centers and other institutions providing services to the youth as identified in the ordinance.
- e) To assist the national government and government agencies in the promotion of programs projects and activities in the local level.
- f) To assist various government and non-government agencies in the identification and nomination of qualified participants different programs, projects and activities.
- g) To conduct fund raising programs and solicitations. It shall likewise receive donations, bequests and may enter into contracts with the government and non-government agencies necessary for the accomplishment of the objectives of this ordinance.

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- h) To recommend youth programs and project proposals to appropriate government agencies and non-government organizations necessary for the accomplishment of the objectives of this ordinance.
- i) To accredit training pools for the purpose of assisting line agency in implementation training and capability building programs.
- j) To solicit books and receive donation from any individual non-government agencies both local and international.
- k) To create research team that will formulate a mechanism to come up with a local youth stationers.
- I) To establish youth centers as deemed necessary.
- m) To monitor implementation of programs and projects at the local level.
- n) To nominate its delegate to the National Youth Parliament, and
- o) To perform such other functions as may be provided by law.

SECTION 8. Secretariat - The Secretariat of the LDYC shall be the Youth Affairs and Sports Development Office (YASDO) which shall provide technical assistance to the LDYC. Communications to other agencies within and outside of the LDYC shall also be a function of the secretariat.

SECTION 9. *Meetings* – The council shall meet quarterly (every three (3) months) or as often as maybe deemed necessary. The chairman or his duly designated convener shall preside in all council meetings.

SECTION 10. *Appropriations* – The local government unit shall incorporate in its annual budget such amount as may be necessary for the operation and effective functioning of the local youth development council.

SECTION 11. Separability Clause – If, for any reason or reasons, any part or provisions of this ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 12. *Repealing Clause.* All previous ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance shall be deemed repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 13. *Effectivity Clause* – This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
