EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 18
Series of 2021

**PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENTS TO EXECUTIVE ORDER NO 23, SERIES OF 2019,
WHICH AMENDED EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 14, SERIES OF 2018,
ON THE APPOINTMENT AND INCLUSION OF INDIVIDUALS IN THE
MUNTINLUPA ANTI-DRUG ABUSE COUNCIL**

WHEREAS, Section 51, Article VII of Republic Act No. 9165, otherwise known as the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002, provides that "(1) *local government units shall appropriate a substantial portion of their annual budgets to assist in or enhance the enforcement of this Act giving priority to preventive or educational programs and the rehabilitation or treatment of drug dependents;*"

WHEREAS, the City Government of Muntinlupa converted and renamed the Muntinlupa Anti-Drug Abuse Prevention and Control Council into the Drug Abuse Prevention and Control Office, in compliance to City Ordinance No. 2002-67, dated 17 October 2002, serving as the focal point and effective mechanism in orchestrating the campaign against illegal drugs;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 23, Series of 2019, provided for amendments to Executive Order No. 14, Series of 2018, and created the Muntinlupa Anti-Drug Abuse Council, its composition and functions;

WHEREAS, there is a necessity to reflect the changes in the composition of the Council mentioned in the preceding paragraph;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jaime R. Fresnedi, City Mayor of Muntinlupa, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order and decree that:

Section 1. Re-Composition.

The Muntinlupa Anti-Drug Abuse Council (MADAC, *for brevity*), shall, from hereon, be composed of the following individuals, with their respective designations, namely:

Membership in the MADAC is a function of the office which the elected official or appointed officer occupies. Hence, the resignation, cessation of employment, removal, transfer, severe incapacity, death, or any other similarly-situated circumstance of any public member hereof shall entitle the successor to assume membership without the need for issuance of another instrument.

In the case of members belonging to the private sector found in a situation mentioned above, the City Mayor shall appoint another individual according to the recommendation of the members of MADAC and of the DAPCO.

Section 2. Functions.

The MADAC shall continue to perform the following functions, namely:

- (a) Observe proper and regular attendance in all meetings duly called for;
- (b) Serve as the focal point through which individuals and organizations may work and cooperate in the planning, implementation and evaluation of programs, projects and activities on drug abuse prevention and control;
- (c) Provide an effective framework for the coordination of existing services and plans, including those for development ahead;
- (d) Provide the mechanism for sourcing of funds, recruitment of volunteers, acquisition of facilities and technical expertise, among others, and coordinate with individuals and organizations, both private and public, for this purpose;
- (e) Perform such other functions as the City Mayor or competent authority may direct, or as may be necessary in order to achieve the foregoing.

Section 3. Secretariat.

The Secretariat shall ably assist the MADAC in the discharge of its functions. It shall be composed of the following individuals, with their respective designations, namely:

Furthermore, the Secretariat shall perform the following functions, namely:

- (a) Issue Notices of Meeting, whether regular or special;
- (b) Ensure logistical support thereto;
- (c) Write, record and disseminate Minutes of Meeting;
- (d) Write, record, send, file correspondence;
- (e) Coordinate administrative requirements;
- (f) Perform such other functions as may be necessary.

Section 4. Repealing Clause.

Previously issued orders or directives deemed inconsistent with any provision found herein shall be deemed repealed, revoked or amended accordingly.


Section 5. Separability Clause.

In the event any provision found herein shall be judicially struck down illegal or administratively declared infirm, untouched provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. Effectivity Clause.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its signing, and its shall remain in full force and effect until repealed, revoked or amended accordingly.
