**EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 5**  
Series of 2020

**PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF THE LOCAL ROAD CLEARING ASSESSMENT TEAM  
OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF MUNTINLUPA, ITS COMPOSITION AND FUNCTIONS**

**WHEREAS**, Section 17 (b) (2) (viii) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that a municipality shall provide services on “(i)nfrastructure facilities intended primarily to service the needs of the residents of the municipality and which are funded out of municipal funds, including, but not limited to, municipal roads and bridges; school buildings and other facilities for public elementary and secondary schools; clinics; health centers and other health facilities necessary to carry out health services; communal irrigation, small water impounding projects and other similar projects; fish ports; artesian wells, spring development, rainwater collectors, and water supply systems; seawalls, dikes, drainage and sewerage, and flood control; traffic signals and road signs; and similar facilities;”

**WHEREAS**, Section 17 (b) (4), *supra*, provides that the city shall provide “(a)ll the services and facilities of the municipality and province;”

**WHEREAS**, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte, during his 4th State of the Nation Address delivered on 22 July 2019, directed all local government units to reclaim public roads being used for private ends;

**WHEREAS**, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) issued Memorandum Circular No. 2019-121 with subject “Presidential Directive During the 4<sup>th</sup> State of the Nation Address of the President to Clear Roads of Illegal Structures and Constructions,” and directed all local government units to clear local roads of illegal obstructions;

**WHEREAS**, the DILG also issued Memorandum Circular No. 2020-027 with subject “Continued Implementation of the Presidential Directive to Clear Roads of Illegal Obstructions (Road Clearing 2.0),” which provided additional guidelines on the conduct of road clearing activities of LGUs and directed all local government units to continue their road clearing efforts;

**WHEREAS**, DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2020-027 also calls for the creation of a validation team for every province, city, municipality and barangay which shall regularly interface with the local chief executive, or their representatives, to discuss the implementation and compliance of the LGU with the road clearing directives;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jaime R. Fresnedi, City Mayor of Muntinlupa**, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order and decree the following, namely:

Section 1. Creation and Composition.

The Local Road Clearing Assessment Team (LRCAT, *for brevity*) of the City of Muntinlupa is hereby created, and it shall be composed of the following individuals, with their respective designation, namely:

Section 2. Functions.

The LRCAT shall perform the following functions, namely:

- (a) Conduct monthly unannounced inspections to assess and evaluate the efforts of the nine (9) barangays of the city in ensuring that the presidential directive on road clearing is followed through;

- (b) Interface with the City Mayor and/or the Muntinlupa Task Force Discipline once every two weeks to discuss the status of implementation and compliance of the city and the barangays with the road clearing directive;
- (c) Meet once a month, or as needed, to discuss the result of the monthly inspections, due for reporting to the City Mayor;
- (d) Report monthly to the City Mayor and endorse the monthly assessment results and status of compliance of the barangays, copy furnished the Sangguniang Panlungsod; and
- (e) Perform such other functions as may be directed by competent authority, or as may be necessary to achieve the foregoing.

Section 3. Secretariat.

The staff members of the Public Information Office shall form the Secretariat, and the head of which shall be Mr. Rovi Viloría. The Secretariat shall perform the following functions, namely:

- (a) Issue Notices of Meeting for every regular or special meeting;
- (b) Prepare the logistical support for such meeting;
- (c) Write down, record and disseminate the Minutes of Meeting;
- (d) Write down, receive, prepare and send out correspondence;
- (e) Prepare and follow through on all administrative requirements;
- (f) Perform such other functions as may be directed by competent authority, or as may be necessary to achieve the foregoing.

Section 4. Repealing Clause.

All orders and directives inconsistent with provisions herein found are deemed repealed, revoked or amended accordingly.

Section 5. Separability Clause.

Any provision herein judicially declared illegal or infirm shall not affect untouched provisions.
