**PROVIDING FOR FURTHER AMENDMENTS TO EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 23 ON THE
CREATION OF THE MANILA BAY CLEAN-UP, PRESERVATION AND REHABILITATION
TASK FORCE OF THE CITY OF MUNTINLUPA,
ITS COMPOSITION AND FUNCTIONS, AS FIRST AMENDED BY EXECUTIVE ORDER NO.
2, Series of 2015**

WHEREAS, Section 16, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that “(t)he State shall protect and advance the right of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature;”

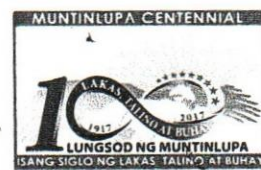
WHEREAS, Section 445 (b) (2) (iii), Chapter 3, Title III of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that the local chief executive shall “(i)ssue such executive orders for the faithful and appropriate enforcement and execution of laws and ordinances;”

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court, in its decision in the case of *Metropolitan Manila Development Authority, et al, vs. Concerned Residents of Manila Bay (G.R. No. 171947-48)*, dated 18 December 2008, ordered the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), together with twelve (12) other national agencies/offices, in a continuing mandamus, to clean-up, preserve and rehabilitate Manila Bay;

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court, in the same decision, ordered the coordinative and collective efforts of local government units and their respective instrumentalities, of national government agencies and of the private sector;

WHEREAS, an unnumbered Memorandum was issued by the DILG, dated 02 May 2011, directing all city and municipal mayors of the National Capital Region to cause the organization/creation of the Manila Bay Clean-Up, Preservation and Rehabilitation Task Force (Manila Bay Task Force) in their respective local government units;

WHEREAS, in compliance thereto, the Office of the City Mayor issued Executive Order No. 23, Series of 2014, providing for the creation of the Manila Bay Clean-Up, Preservation and





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Rehabilitation Task Force (Manila Bay Task Force) of the City of Muntinlupa, Its Composition and Functions, dated 03 January 2014;

WHEREAS, there is a need to further expand the membership of the MBCPR Task Force to include other city officials and agencies whose regular roles and responsibilities are related and can contribute to the improved functionality of the same;

WHEREAS, there is a need to designate a co-chairperson to represent the City Mayor during the regular meetings of the MBCPR Task Force and lead the team in the achievement of its various targets;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ATTY. JAIME R. FRESNEDI, City Mayor of Muntinlupa, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order and decree that:

Section 1. Creation and Composition.

The composition of the Manila Bay Clean-Up, Preservation and Rehabilitation Task Force of the City of Muntinlupa (Manila Bay Task Force, *for brevity*) is amended as follows, namely:

Section 2. Duties and Responsibilities of the Co-chairperson.

The Head of the Environmental Protection and Natural Resources Office is designated as the co-chairperson of the MBCPR Task Force, and as such, shall perform the following duties and responsibilities, to wit:





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1. Represent the City Mayor in every MBCPR Task Force meeting;
2. Communicate to the MBCPR Task Force the thrust and directives of the City Mayor with regards to the implementation of the MBCPR Program;
3. Monitor and lead the MBCPR Task Force towards the achievement of the directives of the Supreme Court as reflected in the MBCPR Key Performance Indicators;
4. Report to the City Mayor the activities and accomplishments of the team as well as the relevant concerns and support needed to improve its performance; and
5. Perform such other functions which may heretofore be assigned by law or executive issuance.

Section 3. Repealing Clause.

Any order, memorandum, or similarly situated directive deemed inconsistent with any provision of this executive order is hereby amended, repealed, revoked or superseded accordingly.

Section 4. Effectivity.

This executive order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in full force until otherwise decreed or ordered.
