## EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 69 Series of 2019

PROVIDING FOR FURTHER AMENDMENTS EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 17,
SERIES OF 2016, WHICH AMENDED SECTIONS 1 AND 3 OF EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 9,
SERIES OF 2013, FOR PURPOSES OF RECOGNIZING THE NEW COMPOSITION OF THE
ANTI-GRAFT BOARD OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF MUNTINLUPA

**WHEREAS,** under Circular No. 87-02 of the then ministry of Local Government, by virtue of which the Anti-Graft Board was created, "All Governors, City and Municipal Mayors are directed to give special and particular attention to the creation of the aforementioned Anti-Graft Board;"

**WHEREAS,** Executive Order No. 9, Series of 2013, was issued on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of September 2013 providing for the reorganization and institutionalization of the Anti-Graft Board of the City of Muntinlupa, Its Composition and Functions;

**WHEREAS,** in line with the present administration's aggressive stance against graft and corruption, the Anti-Graft Board has even more intensified its campaign;

**WHEREAS,** Executive Order No. 17, Series of 2016, was issued on the 22nd day of August 2016, providing for amendments to Executive Order No. 9, Series of 2013;

**WHEREAS,** there is a need to amend Executive Order No. 17, Series of 2016, inasmuch as Atty. Pio Chan, Chairperson, and Rev. Fr. Rosello Hernandez have tendered their respective resignations;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Executive Order No. 17, Series of 2016, the honoraria received, per meeting, shall be Five Thousand Pesos and Four Thousand Pesos for the Chairperson and the members thereof, respectively;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, JAIME R. FRESNEDI,** City Mayor of Muntinlupa, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order and decree that:





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Section 1.

Changes in the Composition.

The Anti-Graft Board of the City Government of Muntinlupa, from hereon, shall be composed of the following individuals with their corresponding designations, namely:

Section 2.

Honoraria.

Subject to sound and relevant accounting and budgetary rules and regulations, the Chairman shall be entitled to Five Thousand (Php5,000.00) Pesos per meeting/session, while each Member shall draw Four Thousand (Php4,000.00) Pesos per meeting/session; Provided, that the number of meetings shall not exceed four (4) per month..

Section 3.

Repealing Clause.

Any order or similar directive deemed inconsistent with this Executive Order shall be deemed repealed, revoked, amended or superseded accordingly.

Section 4.

Effectivity Clause.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon signing, and it shall remain in full force and effect until repealed, revoked, amended or superseded accordingly.
