EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 5

PROVIDING FOR THE DESIGNATION OF THE LOCAL POPULATION OFFICER OF THE CITY OF MUNTINLUPA, AND ITS FUNCTIONS

WHEREAS, Section 12, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that "(t)he State recognizes the sanctity of life and shall protect and strengthen the family as a basic autonomous social institution;"

WHEREAS, Section 14, Article XIII, *supra*, provides that "(t)he State shall protect working women by providing safe and healthful working conditions, taking into account their maternal functions, and such facilities and opportunities that will enhance their welfare and enable them to realize their full potential in the service of the nation;"

WHEREAS, Section 3 (o) of Republic Act No. 10354, otherwise known as the Responsible Parenthood and Reproductive Health Act, provides that "(d)evelopment is a multi-faceted process that calls for the harmonization and integration of policies, plans, programs and projects that seek to uplift the quality of life of the people, more particularly the poor, needy and the marginalized;"

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte has repeatedly invoked it a national policy and priority the full implementation of the National Program on Population and Family Planning (NPPFP);

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) issued Memorandum Circular No. 2019-100, and dated 08 July 2019, mandating the designation of a Local Population Officer in each local government unit;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jaime R. Fresnedi, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order and decree that:

Section 1. Designation.

Mildred Paliza-Andaleon, Planning Officer IV, is hereby designated as the Local Population Officer of the City of Muntinlupa.

Section 2. Functions.

- a. Serve as the focal person or action officer for the implementation of strategies related to the program on population and family planning at the local level;
- Coordinate with local departments and offices, including the nine (9) barangays of the City of Muntinlupa, the planning and conduct of critical strategies for the full implementation of the program on population and family planning which is barangaybased within the locality;
- Mobilize community workers to map and locate couples and individuals with unmet need for modern family planning methods;
- d. Conduct intensive community-based demand generation and referral activities, and ensure provision of quality modern Family Planning information and services guided by the principle of informed choice and volunteerism;
- e. Engage, collaborate, and partner with relevant government agencies such as the Department of Health (DOH) and Population Commission (POPCOM), civil society organizations, and other private sector individuals and groups in attaining and sustaining unmet need for modern family planning methods;
- f. Generate and mobilize necessary resources for the implementation of the program within the City of Muntinlupa;
- g. Sustain continuing training and capacity-building activities to be designed and supported by the national program under Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2019-01, series of 2018, of DOH-NEDA-POPCOM, recruitment and deployment of Barangay Service Point Officers (BSPO) and other community-based population volunteers and continually support them through logistics provision and monetary and/or non-monetary incentives as appropriate and allowable; and
- h. Perform such other functions as may be directed by competent authority or as may be deemed necessary to achieve the foregoing.

Section 3. Repealing Clause.

All orders and similar directives inconsistent with any provision found herein shall be deemed repealed, revoked, rescinded, amended or superseded accordingly.
