



### EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 16 Series of 2019

#### PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF THE CITY OF MUNTINLUPA RESILIENCE COUNCIL, ITS COMPOSITION AND FUNCTIONS

**WHEREAS,** the National Resilience Council (NRC) was launched on 13 October 2017 in support of the 2017 International Day for Disaster Risk Reduction;

**WHEREAS,** NRC's goals include to foster a strong partnership between the private and public sectors, to make the country resilient and to address one of the seven Global Targets of the Sendai Framework, which is to substantially reduce the number of people affected globally from disaster by 2030;

**WHEREAS,** the City of Muntinlupa has pledged to work with the NRC and to pursue the continuing agenda of building a resilient Philippines;

**WHEREAS,** it is necessary to create a counterpart local council to be known as the City of Muntinlupa Resilience Council to coordinate all efforts in ensuring disaster preparedness and response and to further realize the goals and objectives of the NRC in the local level;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jaime R. Fresnedi, City Mayor of Muntinlupa,** by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order and decree that:

Section 1.

Creation and Composition.

The City of Muntinlupa Resilience Council (*Munreco, for brevity*) is hereby created, and it shall be composed of the following individuals, namely:

Membership in the Munreco is a function of the office occupied by the individual. In case of resignation, removal, transfer, incapacity, death or any similarly-situated circumstance, the successor thereof shall assume membership in the Munreco without need for the issuance of another order or instrument.

Section 2.

Functions.

The Munreco shall perform the following functions, namely:

- Ensure disaster resilience and effective response protocols and systems are in place in the City of Muntinlupa;
- Understand connection of disaster risks in all their dimensions, including vulnerability, capacity, exposure of individuals and properties, characteristics of hazards, topography, environment, among others;
- Manage and strengthen disaster risk governance through collaboration and partnerships;
- Invest in the economic, social, health and cultural dimensions of disaster risk management;
- e. Enhance disaster preparedness for effective response and implement the policy of "Build Back Better" in recovery, rehabilitation and reconstruction endeavors, and, as a means to this end, take a pro-active stance in integrating disaster risk reduction in infrastructure and development plans;
- f. Coordinate with the NRC regarding the performance of the City of Muntinlupa on resilience indicators; and
- g. Perform such other functions as may be necessary to accomplish the foregoing, or as may be directed by competent authority.

Section 3.

Secretariat.

The staff members of the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office shall form the Secretariat of the Munreco. Ana Vanessa Medroso shall act as the head thereof. The Secretariat shall be responsible for preparation and issuance of Notice of Meetings; for preparation of meeting venues; for taking down, recording and dissemination of Minutes of Meetings; for correspondence; and for other functions attached to the Secretariat.,

Section 4.

Funding.

Expenses related to the operations and discharge of functions of the Munreco shall be sourced from the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund.

Section 5.

Repealing Clause.

All orders and other directives found inconsistent with any provision herein shall be deemed repealed, revoked, rescinded or amended accordingly.

Section 6.

Effectivity Clause.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately, and it shall remain in full force and effect until repealed, revoked, rescinded or amended accordingly.
