EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 16
Series of 2020

**PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF THE BARANGAY TASK FORCE
ON MONITORING COMPLIANCE IN THE TIME OF MODIFIED ENHANCED COMMUNITY
QUARANTINE, ITS COMPOSITION AND FUNCTIONS**

WHEREAS, Item A.1.c. of Resolution No. 35, Series of 2020, issued by the Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases provides that “the following high-risk provinces, HUCs, and ICCs, shall be placed under Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ) until 31 May 2020, without prejudice to the declaration of localized Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ) in critical areas:

- i. For Luzon – Laguna, all HUCs of the National Capital Region (NCR) and the Municipality of Pateros; and
- ii. For Visayas – Cebu City;”

WHEREAS, the IATF, through Presidential Spokesperson Harry L. Roque, released graphics on the list of establishments allowed to operate, either fully or partially, the set of protocols, and other standards that have to be enforced in areas placed under MECQ;

WHEREAS, although the imposition of MECQ is a transition from ECQ towards General Community Quarantine, standards, nonetheless, have to be mandated in order to build on the gains made by the City Government of Muntinlupa (CGM) against the covid-19 pandemic, since the imposition of ECQ on 15 March 2020;

WHEREAS, a more inclusive approach to monitoring compliance can best be achieved by barangays, inasmuch as they are grounded on the realities of their respective communities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jaime R. Fresnedi, City Mayor of Muntinlupa, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order and decree that:

Section 1. Creation and Composition.

For each of the nine (9) barangays of the City of Muntinlupa, the Barangay Task Force on Monitoring Compliance in the time of Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ) is hereby created, and it shall be composed of the following individuals, with their respective designations, namely:

Section 2. Functions.

The Barangay Task Force shall perform the following functions, namely:

- Convene for a meeting, at least once a week, and provide reports, feedbacks, and other information necessary in the successful implementation of the standards under MECQ;
- Conduct inspection in their respective Barangays based on the guidelines of the IATF;
- Submit to the City Mayor, through the Business Permits and Licensing Office, and for appropriate action, its findings on non-compliance with the guidelines set forth by the IATF;
- Share with fellow barangays best practices of business establishments for replication;
- Perform such other functions as may be directed by competent authority, or as may be necessary to achieve the foregoing.

Section 3. Minimum Health Standards.

The following minimum health standards shall be observed in business establishments, namely:



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- a. Wearing of face mask among officers, staff members and clients. A policy of “no face mask, no entry” shall be observed;
- b. Thorough and frequent washing of hands of officers and staff members;
- c. Providing alcohol-based hand sanitizers for workers and clients;
- d. Keeping safe physical distance between and among individuals, i.e. at least a meter apart, and towards this end, reconfiguring work spaces, visitors’ receiving area, among others;
- e. Placing markers containing reminders on proper observance of health protocols in conspicuous places;
- f. Using thermal scanners among officers, staff members and clients, and reporting immediately individuals manifesting high fever and other related symptoms, if evident;
- g. Forming and implementing health protocols, subject to the guidance and approval of the City Health Office, for higher-risk occupations, industries, and similarly-situated spaces;
- h. Allowing no more than fifty (50%) percent of the workforce to be physically present at any given time, and organizing flexible work arrangements for the remaining half;
- i. Subjecting officers and staff members to anti-body testing and confirmatory polymerise chain reaction (PCR) testing, as a condition for issuing return-to-work order;
- j. Providing shuttle services and/or other modes of transportation to and from the place of work for all employees.

Section 4. Application.

In the event that the MECQ imposition is lifted, the Barangay Task Force shall remain subsisting and in effect. Likewise, it applies in the event an order for a revert to Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ), or a downgrade to General Community Quarantine (GCQ), Modified General Community Quarantine (MGCQ) and New Normal, as the case may be, is issued accordingly.

Section 5. Recourse.

In the event of ambiguity or doubt in the application of the guidelines set forth by the IATF, the Barangay Task Force shall call upon the assistance of the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office.



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Section 6. Repealing Clause.

Any order or directive that is inconsistent with any provision herein found shall be deemed repealed, revoked or amended accordingly.


Section 7. Separability Clause.

In the event that any provision herein found is struck down as illegal, by judicial decision, or infirm, by administrative finding, untouched provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 8. Effectivity Clause.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon signing, and it shall remain in full force and effect until repealed, revoked or amended accordingly.
