EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 21
Series of 2019

**PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENTS TO EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 19, SERIES OF 2016,
ON THE REORGANIZATION OF THE PEOPLE'S LAW ENFORCEMENT BOARD,
ITS COMPOSITION AND SECRETARIAT**

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Republic Act No. 6975, otherwise known as An Act Establishing the Philippine National Police under a Reorganized Department of the Interior and Local Government, and for Other Purposes, provides that "(i)t is hereby declared to be the policy of the State to promote peace and order, ensure public safety and further strengthen local government capability aimed towards the effective delivery of the basic services to the citizenry through the establishment of a highly efficient and competent police force that is national in scope and civilian in character. Towards this end, the State shall bolster a system of coordination and cooperation among the citizenry, local executives and the integrated law enforcement and public safety agencies created under this Act;"

WHEREAS, the same statute provides for every city and municipality to create and establish a People's Law Enforcement Board (PLEB, *for brevity*), which shall be the central receiving entity for any complaint emanating from a citizen against officers and members of the Philippine National Police (PNP, *for brevity*); and, subject to the provisions of Section 41, *supra*, the PLEB shall take cognizance of or refer the complaint to the proper disciplinary or adjudicatory authority within three (3) days upon filing of the complaint;

WHEREAS, recent changes in election of officials and movements in personnel and the expiration of the term of members of the PLEB necessitate the introduction of amendments to Executive Order No. 19, Series of 2016, which provided amendments to Executive Orders No. 3 and 3-A, Series of 2014, respectively;

WHEREAS, the reorganization of the PLEB shall facilitate the expeditious resolution of cases filed against errant officers and personnel of the PNP;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jaime R. Fresnedi, City Mayor of Muntinlupa, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order and decree that:

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Section 1. Reorganization of the People's Law Enforcement Board.

The People's Law Enforcement Board (PLEB, *for brevity*) of the City of Muntinlupa is hereby reorganized, and it shall be composed, henceforth, of the following individuals, namely:

- (a) Francis Ian T. Bagatsing,
Chairperson, Committee on Public Order, Security and Safety,
Sangguniang Panlungsod,
Duly designated to represent the Sangguniang Panlungsod
pursuant to SP Resolution No. 19-002, Series of 2019;
- (b) Walter A. Arcilla,
President, Liga ng mga Barangay,
Duly designated to represent the Liga ng mga Barangay
pursuant to Liga Resolution No. 2018-001, Series of 2018;
- (c) Atty. Victor C. Lizardo III,
Member of the Philippine Bar;
- (d) L/Col. Estrella N. Tabuco (Ret.),
Member of the Female Sex, and former Naval Officer; and
- (e) J/Col. Demetrio A. Alvarez,
Former Bureau of Jail Management and Penology Officer.

Section 2. Secretariat.

The Secretariat of the PLEB is likewise reorganized, and it shall be composed of the following individuals, with their respective designations, namely:

- (a) Bernadette G. Ferino,
DILG Muntinlupa Local Operations Office..... Head;
- (b) Atty. Tomas Caspe
Private Practitioner..... Investigator;
- (c) National Police Commission (NAPOLCOM)
National Capital Region
Representative.....Consultant;
- (d) DILG Muntinlupa Cluster Head.....Transcriber;
- (e) James Christopher F. Fadrilan..... Typist;
- (f) Jerico R. Bunyi..... Utility;

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- (g) Cecilia A. Argana..... Process Server; and
(h) Jose Salvador S. Parawan..... Driver.

The functions of the Secretariat include the writing down and issuance of Notice of Meeting; the logistical support for any meeting conducted; the writing down, dissemination and recording of Minutes of Meeting; the writing down, receipt and sending out of correspondence; among others.

Section 3. Honorarium.

Pursuant to the seventh Whereas Clause of City Resolution No. 14-053, for every meeting duly attended, the Chairperson of the PLEB shall receive the amount of Three Thousand (Php 3,000.00) Pesos, and for each member thereof the amount of Two Thousand Five Hundred (Php 2,500.00) Pesos.

Moreover, pursuant to the ninth Whereas Clause, *supra*, for every meeting duly facilitated and attended, the members of the Secretariat shall receive the following amounts, namely:

(a) Head.....	Php	10,000.00;
(b) Investigator.....		7,000.00;
(c) NAPOLCOM Representative.....		6,000.00;
(d) Transcriber.....		5,000.00;
(e) Typist.....		5,000.00;
(f) Utility.....		4,000.00;
(g) Process Server.....		3,000.00;
(h) Driver.....		3,000.00.

Section 4. Repealing Clause.

All orders and similar directives inconsistent with any provision hereof shall be deemed revoked, rescinded or amended accordingly.

Section 5. Separability Clause.

Any provision hereof found judicially illegal or infirm shall not affect untouched provisions.

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Section 6. Effectivity Clause.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its signing, and it shall remain in full force and effect until revoked, rescinded or amended accordingly.
