EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 26
Series of 2016

PROVIDING FOR THE REORGANIZATION OF THE PEACE AND ORDER COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF MUNTINLUPA, AND AMENDING, FOR SAID PURPOSE,
EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 5-C, DATED 01 OCTOBER 2015

WHEREAS, Section 116 of Republic Act 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, and Executive Order No. 773, Series of 2009, signed by President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo, the Peace and Order Council of the City of Muntinlupa is hereby reorganized and reconstituted in order to reflect changes in its composition;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Atty. JAIME R. FRESNEDI, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby ordain and decree that:

Section 1. Reorganization of the Composition.

The Peace and Order Council of the City of Muntinlupa (POCCM) is hereby reorganized and reconstituted as follows, namely:

Section 2. Functions.

Pursuant to Section 3 of Executive Order No. 773, Series of 2009, the POCCM shall have the following duties and functions:

- a. Provide a forum for dialogue and deliberations of major issues and problems affecting peace and order, including emergency;
b. Recommend measures which will improve or enhance peace and order and public safety;
c. Recommend measures to converge and orchestrate internal security operations efforts of civil authorities and agencies, military and police;
d. Monitor the provisions of livelihood and infrastructure development programs and projects in marginalized parts of the city to integrate them in all plans of inclusive growth;
e. Perform other functions as may be assigned by law, the President or the National Peace and Order Council; and
f. Perform other functions in order to achieve or to pursue the foregoing.





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Section 3. Technical Working Group.

3.A. A Technical Working Group (TWG) is also hereby created to identify and discuss the agenda for the regular meetings, and, at the same time, discuss the issues that need immediate action by the POCCM. This shall be composed of the following:

3.B. The functions of the TWG are as follows, namely:

- a. Prepare documents that can serve as reference for the profiling of the strategic direction on peace and order and public safety issues in the locality, such as Muntinlupa's Comprehensive Development Plan;
- b. Conduct data gathering and stakeholder consultations, as warranted, and undertake initial analysis of data gathered;
- c. Coordinate with communities and barangays for data-gathering and action planning for implementation of Peace and Order & Public Safety (POPS) Plan;
- d. Present data to the POCCM for prioritization of issues and development of strategies;
- e. Participate in the POPS planning process and draft parts of the POPS Plan as assigned, and participate in the workshop to finalize the POPS Plan.

Section 4. Secretariat.

Pursuant to Section 4, Executive Order No. 773, *supra*, the Secretariat of the MPOC shall be headed by the most senior officer of the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) Muntinlupa. He or she shall be assisted by Roger John P. Smith, Chief Administrative Officer, City Administrator's Office. The Secretariat shall handle the administrative and technical activities of the POCCM, including liaising and coordinating activities with concerned agencies of the government; the preparation of the meeting venue and attendant logistical requirements; the sending of notices for every meeting; the preparation, filing and dissemination of the minutes of the meeting and other functions related to the foregoing.





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The Secretariat shall be composed of the following staff members, assigned at the DILG Muntinlupa City namely:

- a. Marcelina B. Mojica;
- b. James Christopher F. Fadrilan;
- c. Jerico R. Bunyi; and
- d. Cecilia A. Argana.

Section 4. Compensation.

Each member of the POCCM and the TWG shall receive the amount of Php 2,500.00 per month. Members of the Secretariat shall receive the amount of Php 1,000.00 per month. Attendance at every meeting shall be compulsory and shall be a prerequisite for receipt of the allowances. The proof of attendance shall be attached to the minutes of the meeting for auditing purposes.

Section 5. Separability Clause.

All executive orders, regulations, memoranda and other instruments inconsistent with any provisions herein are hereby amended or repealed accordingly.

Section 6. Effectivity Clause.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately, and shall remain in effect until subsequently amended, revoked, rescinded or superseded accordingly.
