EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 26
Series of 2016

PROVIDING FOR THE GRANT OF HONORARIA TO NON-EMPLOYEE MEMBERS OF THE
MUNTINLUPA CENTENNIAL COMMISSION

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 16-005 provides for Creating the Muntinlupa Centennial Commission for the Celebration of the 100th Year Founding Anniversary of Muntinlupa and Appropriating Funds for the Purpose;

WHEREAS, Section 2, *supra*, provides for the composition of the Muntinlupa Centennial Commission (MCC) and items 20 to 23 thereof enumerates members who belong to the private sector and who are not employed at or engaged for their services by the City Government of Muntinlupa;

WHEREAS, the MCC conducts its regular meeting every Wednesday morning and members included in the preceding paragraph incur expenses and, in doing so, use their own personal funds;

WHEREAS, the grant of honorarium to each member contemplated in the preceding paragraphs is equitable and reasonable;

WHEREAS, City Resolution No. 16-063 adopts and approves the Supplemental Annual Investment Program for Centennial Celebration, the budget of which shall be taken from any available fund of the 2016 Executive Budget;

WHEREAS, said Resolution provides for the grant of honoraria for MCC members (non-employee) from July to December 2016, which shall be taken from the General Fund;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Atty. JAIME R. FRESNEDI, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby ordain and decree that:

Section 1. Grant of Honoraria to Each Non-Employee Members.

Each non-employee member of the MCC shall receive the amount of One Thousand Five Hundred (Php 1,500.00) for every meeting duly attended and participated in. The Secretariat of the MCC shall perform all functions necessary to accomplish the said grant, following sound accounting procedures and practices. Meetings shall not exceed four (4) in one (1) month.

Section 2. Members Qualified to Receive Honoraria.

- b. Elvie Sanchez-Quiazon Philippine Chamber of Commerce and Industry,

Section 3. Pending Grant of Honoraria.

Inasmuch as the Chairman of the MCC has not identified the individuals named as entitled for membership in the MCC, provided for under Section 2 of City Ordinance No. 16-005, the following shall be entitled to the same honorarium once they are so acknowledged, namely:

- a. Representative from the National Historical Institute;
- b. Representative from Non-Governmental Organizations;
- c. Not more than five (5) representatives from government or the private sector.

Section 4. Date of Reckoning on the Grant of Honoraria.

The members already qualified to receive their respective honoraria shall be entitled thereto starting on the month of October 2016.

Section 5. Essential Attachments.

The Secretariat shall attach the Minutes of the Meeting and the Attendance Sheets in the processing of the foregoing, absent which, the grant of honoraria shall be disallowed.

Section 6. Effectivity Clause.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain operational until revoked, amended, rescinded or superseded accordingly.
