EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 31
Series of 2017

PROVIDING FOR THE RECONSTITUTION OF THE MUNTINLUPA ECOLOGICAL SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD, DEFINING ITS COMPOSITION AND FUNCTIONS

WHEREAS, Section 16, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that “(t)he State shall protect and advance the right of the people to a balanced and healthful ecology in accord with the rhythm and harmony of nature;

WHEREAS, Section 3 (i) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, mandates that “(l)ocal government units share with the national government the responsibility for the management and maintenance of ecological balance within their territorial jurisdiction, subject to the provisions of this Code and national policies;”

WHEREAS, Section 10, Chapter II of Republic Act No. 9003, otherwise known as the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000, states, among others, “(p)ursuant to the relevant provisions of Republic Act No. 7160, the local government units shall be primarily responsible for the implementation and enforcement of the provisions of this Act within their territorial jurisdiction;”

WHEREAS, Section 12, Chapter II, *supra*, states that “(e)ach city or municipality shall form a city or municipal waste management board that shall prepare, submit and implement a plan for the safe and sanitary management of solid waste generated in areas under its geographic and political coverage;”

WHEREAS, ecological solid waste management, environmental protection and rehabilitation, as well as clean and green program, are among the priorities of the eight-point program of governance of the city;

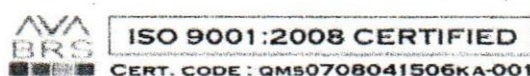
NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jaime R. Fresnedi, City Mayor of Muntinlupa, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order and decree the following:

Section 1. Creation and Composition.

The Muntinlupa Ecological Solid Waste Management Board (MESWMB, *for brevity*) is hereby reconstituted, and it shall be composed of the following individuals, namely:

Membership of public officials and officers in the MESWMB is a function of their office. In the event of resignation from office; removal or cessation of office; incapacity; prolonged absence; or any similarly-situated circumstance, the successor thereto shall assume membership without need of another instrument or document giving effect thereto. For private individuals, however, the resignation or removal from the MESWMB shall not automatically mean their organization will still be represented. The City Mayor shall choose

from names of respectable and capable individuals upon consultation with members of the MESWMB.

Section 2. Functions of the MESWMB.

The MESWMB shall perform the following functions, namely:

- a. Develop a comprehensive and integrative ecological solid waste management plan that will ensure the implementation of long-term management of solid waste, as well as integrate the solid waste management plans and strategies of the barangays, through consultations with different sectors;
- b. Adopt measures to promote and ensure the viability and effective implementation of the Solid Waste Management Program in the barangays;
- c. Monitor and evaluate the implementation of the Ecological Solid Waste Management Plan of the City Government, in cooperation with the private sector, non-governmental and socio-civic organizations, including recyclers and other organizations whose focus rests on the protection and preservation of the environment;
- d. Adopt specific revenue generating measures to promote the viability of the Ecological Solid Waste Management Plan;
- e. Develop the specific mechanics and guidelines for the implementation of the Ecological Solid Waste Management Plan;
- f. Convene regular meetings for purposes of planning and coordinating the implementation of the Ecological Solid Waste Management Plan both on the level of city and barangays;
- g. Review every two (2) years, or as the need arises, the Ecological Solid Waste Management Plan to ensure its adaptability, efficacy, sustainability, viability and relevance, especially in light of trends and developments both locally and internationally;
- h. Recommend to international, national and local authorities and agencies specific measures and proposals for franchise; build-operate-transfer (BOT) scheme or agreement; foreign grant, aid or loan with duly recognized institutions; and, pursuant to Republic Act No. 6957, provide either exclusive or non-exclusive authority for the

collection, transfer, storage, processing, recycling, and disposal of waste. Proposals shall take into account relevant laws and government rules and regulations on contracts, franchises and BOT agreements;

- i. Review and recommend resolutions and ordinances to the Sangguniang Panlungsod and Sangguniang Pambarangay that will ensure enforcement and implementation of the Ecological Solid Waste Management Plan, both in the level of city and barangay, respectively;
- j. Recommend appropriate measures for the effective carrying out of the foregoing to the City Mayor, and perform such other functions as may be necessary related to the foregoing.

Section 3. Technical Working Group.

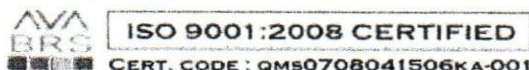
The Technical Working Group (TWG, *for brevity*) of the MESWMB is hereby created, and it shall be composed of the following, namely:

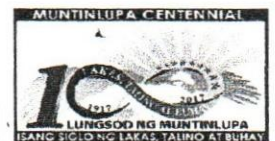
Section 4. Functions of the TWG.

The TWG shall perform the following functions, namely:

- a. Meet and convene regularly and specially, if warranted;
- b. Initiate the development of plans and strategies involving related departments and offices of the City Government;
- c. Recommend these plans and strategies, including conduct of activities, meetings, or seminars to the MESWMB; and
- d. Perform such other functions to achieve the foregoing.

Section 5. Secretariat.

Select staff members, to be duly appointed by Lorna B. Misa, of the Environmental Protection and Natural Resources Office (EPNRO), the Environmental Sanitation Center (ESC) and the City Planning and Development Office (CPDO) shall comprise the Secretariat. The Head of the Secretariat shall be Engr. Andrei M. Argana.

The Secretariat shall be responsible for the preparation and issuance of notices of, and the logistical requirements of, regular and special meetings; the management of all administrative requirements of the MESWMB and the TWG; preparation, filing and sending of correspondence; preparation, recording and dissemination of minutes of meetings; and other functions as may be necessary.

Section 6. Meetings.

The MESWMB shall meet at least once every quarter, or as often as required by the Chairperson. The TWG, on the other hand, shall meet at least once a month. To constitute a quorum, majority of the members shall be sufficient.


Section 7. Repealing Clause.

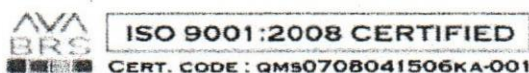

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon signing.
