PROVIDING FOR FURTHER AMENDMENTS TO
EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 14, SERIES OF 2017, WHICH AMENDED
EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 15, SERIES OF 2015 AND
EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 14, SERIES OF 2013,
ON THE REORGANIZED COMPOSITION OF THE
LOCAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCIL OF
MUNTINLUPA CITY AND ITS TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP, AND FUNCTIONS

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 14, Series of 2013 created the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council of Muntinlupa City, its Technical Working Group, their composition and respective functions;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 15, Series of 2015, introduced amendments to Executive Order No. 14, Series of 2013;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 14, Series of 2017, introduced further amendments to Executive Order No. 15, Series of 2015;

WHEREAS, there is a need to reorganize and expand the current composition of the Council and its Technical Working Group in order to properly prepare and accomplish its list of Programs, Projects and Activities, and ensure these are aligned with the utilization of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund;

WHEREAS, the Council, in the discharge of its functions, seeks to involve the Technical Working Group in the conduct of the technical formulation, monitoring, evaluation and reporting of programs, project and activities and closely coordinate concerns of involved members of the Council:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JAIME R. FRESNEDI, City Mayor of Muntinlupa, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law do hereby decree and order that:

Section 1. Reorganization and Expansion of the Composition of the Council.

Section 1 of Executive Order No. 14, Series of 2017 is hereby amended to read as follows, to wit:

Membership in the Council, for those in the public service, is an attribute of the office which each holds. Henceforth, the death, resignation, removal from office, termination, transfer, or similarly-situated circumstance shall enable the successor to assume membership in the Council without need for the issuance of another Executive Order. However, in the case of those from the private sector, remaining members of the Council shall submit a list of prospective replacements to the Office of the City Mayor. The City Mayor shall decide and appoint the new member not later than thirty (30) days from the date of departure of the predecessor.

Section 2.

Functions of the Council

Section 2 of Executive Order No. 14, Series of 2013, is hereby retained, hence:

- a. approve, monitor and evaluate the implementation of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan (LDRRMP), and annually review, test and develop the plan consistent with other national and local planning programs;
- ensure the integration of disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation into local development plans, programs and budgets as a strategy in sustainable development and poverty reduction;
- c. recommend the implementation of forced or pre-emptive evacuation of local residents, if necessary; and
- d. convene the local Council as provided by City Ordinance No. 13-077 and Republic Act
 No. 10121, and its Implementing Rules and Regulations.

Additionally, the following shall be functions of the Council, namely:

- e. plan and institutionalize effective, comprehensive and proper monitoring mechanisms in order to ensure that budget utilization of the LDPPMP and related budgetary allocations are utilized correctly and attuned to existing rules imposed by the Commission on Audit, the City Accounting Office, among others;
- f. invite and ingratiate public sector involvement in all works of the MCDDRRMO, whether undertaken on its own or as passed down by competent authority, in order to ensure public buy-in of all programs, projects and activities;
- g. perform such other functions as may be directed by competent authority, or as may be necessary to accomplish the foregoing.

Section 3. Creation and Composition of the Council Technical Working Group.

The Technical Working Group of the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management of Council of Muntinlupa City (Council TWG, *for brevity*) is hereby created, and it shall be composed of one (1) representative from the following offices, namely:

Section 4. Functions of the Council TWG.

The Council TWG shall have the following functions, namely:

- a. organize technical meetings of the Council and the Council TWG;
- generate Programs, Projects and Activities (PPAs) that are aligned with the Local
 Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMF);
- c. establish procedures and indicators, and assess, monitor and evaluate accomplishment results of PPAs in the utilization of the LDRRMF;

- d. assist in the implementation of the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan;
- e. serve as technical resource persons of the Council;
- f. perform such other functions as may be directed by competent authority, or as may be necessary to accomplish the foregoing.

Section 5. Secretariat.

The Secretariat shall be composed of Cyril D. Gonzalodo, Caroleen O. Oñez, Manuel S. Flor, Jr., of the Muntinlupa City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MCDRRMO), the Head of which shall be Erwin O. Alfonso, the Head of the MCDRRMO. The Secretariat shall be responsible for issuance of notices of meetings; logistical support for meetings; writing down, dissemination and filing of minutes of meeting; preparation, sending and recording of correspondence; liaison with concerned individuals and groups, whether from the private or public sector, among others.

Section 6. Allowance.

Subject to existing rules and regulations and availability of funds, proper documentation, reportorial requirements, and documented attendance, each member of the Council shall receive an allowance in the amount of Two Thousand Five Hundred (Php 2,500.00) Pesos for every meeting attended, which shall not exceed two (2) meetings for every quarter.

Each member of the Council TWG shall receive an allowance in the amount of Two Thousand (Php 2,000.00) Pesos for every meeting attended, which shall not exceed three (3) meetings for every quarter.

Section 7. Repealing Clause.

All orders, memoranda, and other similarly-situated directives inconsistent with any provision contained is hereby repealed, revoked, rescinded or amended accordingly.

Section 8.

Separability Clause.

Any provision herein found judicially or administratively declared unlawful or infirm shall not affect untouched provisions, which shall remain in full and effect.

Section 9.

Effectivity Clause.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon signing, and it shall remain in full force and effect until repealed, revoked, rescinded or amended accordingly.
