### EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 11 Series of 2022-B

PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENTS TO EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 23, SERIES OF 2019,
AND EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 14, SERIES OF 2018,
ON THE CREATION OF THE MUNTINLUPA ANTI-DRUG ABUSE COUNCIL,
ITS COMPOSITION AND FUNCTIONS

WHEREAS, Section 51, Article VII of Republic Act No. 9165, otherwise known as the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002, provides that "(l)ocal government units shall appropriate a substantial portion of their annual budgets to assist in or enhance the enforcement of this Act giving priority to preventive or educational programs and the rehabilitation or treatment of drug dependents;"

WHEREAS, the City Government of Muntinlupa converted and renamed the Muntinlupa Anti-Drug Abuse Prevention and Control Council into the Drug Abuse Prevention and Control Office (DAPCO, *for brevity*), in compliance to the City Ordinance no 2002-67, dated 17 October 2002, serving as the focal point and effective mechanism in orchestrating the campaign against illegal drugs;

**WHEREAS**, drug abuse continues to be a societal menace, requiring concerted and multi-faceted responses and multi-sectoral involvement;

**WHEREAS**, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) Memorandum Circular No. 98-227, dated 02 December 1998, enjoins all local government units to create a local Anti-Drug Abuse Council with corresponding composition, roles and responsibilities;

**WHEREAS,** in order to strengthen and revitalize the campaign against illegal drug use, and for the foregoing reasons, the creation of the Muntinlupa Anti-Drug Abuse Council (MADAC) is both essential and immediate;

**WHEREAS,** Executive Order No. 14, Series of 2018, provided for the creation of the Muntinlupa Anti-Drug Abuse Council, for its composition and functions, and this was later amended by Executive Order No. 23, Series of 2019;

**WHEREAS,** recent changes necessitate the introduction of amendments to the two foregoing issuances;

**NOW, THEREFORE,** *I, Rozzano Rufino B. Biazon, City Mayor of Muntinlupa,* by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order and decree that:

Section 1. Re-Composition.

In the event of resignation, removal, transfer, severe incapacity, grave illness, death, or other similarly-situated circumstance of any member included in the enumeration above, the successor shall assume membership in the Council without need for further issuance of any instrument. In the case of members belonging to the private sector in the same situation abovementioned, the City Mayor shall appoint another individual according to the recommendation made by other members of the MADAC.

Section 2. Functions.

The MADAC shall perform the following functions, namely:

- Observe proper and regular attendance in all meetings called for; a.
- b. Serve as the focal point through which various individuals and organizations work and cooperate together in the planning, implementation and evaluation of programs and activities regarding drug abuse prevention;
- Provide an effective framework for the coordination of existing services and C. programs as well as those for development in the future;
- d. Provide the mechanism for sourcing of funds, volunteers, facilities, technical expertise, among others, and coordinate with other individuals and organizations, both private and public, for this purpose;
- Approve a comprehensive City Anti-Drug Plan of Action, with corresponding targets e. per quarter, as included in the City POPS Plan, such as, but not limited to:
  - Capacity development programs for all stakeholders through prevention education, drug clearing operations, rehabilitation programs, reformation program;
  - Advocacy programs on the effects and legal consequences of illegal drugs, role ii. of family and the youth in the fight against illegal drugs, among others;
- Perform such other functions as competent authority may hand down, or as e. necessary for the successful implementation of the foregoing.

Section 3. Secretariat.

The Secretariat of the Council shall be composed of the following staff members from the DAPCO, namely:

The Secretariat shall be responsible for the issuance of notices of the meeting, whether regular or special; for the logistical support thereto; for the writing, recording and dissemination of the minutes of the meeting; for the preparation and filing of correspondences; for handling of administrative matters; and for other matters brought before it.

Section 4.

Repealing Clause.

All orders and directives inconsistent with any provision herein found shall be deemed repealed, revoked, or amended accordingly.

Section 5.

Separability Clause.

Should any provision herein be judicially decided illegal or administratively declared infirm, the untouched provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6.

Effectivity Clause.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its signing, and it shall remain in full force until repealed, revoked, or amended accordingly.
