



EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 20 Series of 2022-B

PROVIDING AMENDMENTS TO EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 31, SERIES OF 2018,
EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 14, SERIES OF 2017,
EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 15, SERIES OF 2015, AND
EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 14, SERIES OF 2013
ON THE CREATION OF THE MUNTINLUPA CITY DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND
MANAGEMENT COUNCIL, ITS COMPOSITION AND FUNCTIONS

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10121, otherwise known as the Philippine Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010, mandates the creation of the Local Risk Reduction and Management Council in every local government unit;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 14, Series of 2013, issued on 12 November 2013, provided for the creation of the Muntinlupa City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council, its composition and functions;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 15, Series of 2015, issued on 14 October 2015, provided amendments to Executive Order No. 14, Series of 2013;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 14, Series of 2017, issued on 19 June 2017, provided further amendments to the first two Executive Orders;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 31, Series of 2018, provided further amendments to the first three Executive Orders;

WHEREAS, the need to recreate or reconstitute the Muntinlupa City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (MCDRRMC) is imperative considering the impending hazards and risk that may be brought about by any of the natural and human-induced hazards.

WHEREAS, the Council, in the discharge of its functions, seeks to involve the Technical Working Group in the conduct of the technical formulation, monitoring, evaluation and reporting of programs, project and activities and closely coordinate concerns of involved members of the council:

NOW, THEREFORE, *I, Rozzano Rufino B. Biazon, City Mayor of Muntinlupa,* by the virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order and decree that:

Section 1. Re-Creation and Re-Composition.

The Muntinlupa City Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (MCDRRMC, for brevity), is hereby re-created, and it shall be composed of the following individuals, with their respective designations, namely:

Section 3.

Functions of the Chairperson, Vice Chairpersons and Members.

(a) The Chairperson, assisted by the four (4) Vice Chairpersons, shall provide the overall direction, exercise supervision and effect coordination of relevant DDRM programs. projects and activities;

Every member agency shall be assigned to functions relevant to their mandates and (b) programs in the LDRRMP.

Section 3. Functions of the MCDRRMC.

Pursuant to Republic Act No. 10121, the Council shall perform the following functions, namely:

Approve, monitor and evaluate the implementation of the Local Disaster Risk (a) Reduction and Management Plan (LDRRMPs), and regularly review and test the plan consistent with other national and local planning programs;

(b) Ensure the integration of disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation into local development plans, programs and budgets as a strategy in sustainable development;

Recommend the implementation of forced or pre-emptive evacuation of local (c) residents, if necessary;

Convene the local council once every three (3) months or as often as necessary; (d)

Perform such other functions that are incidental to or are necessary for the (e) performance of disaster risk reduction and management.

Section 4. Civil Society and Private Sector Representative.

The MCDRRMC shall adhere to the guidelines of the National Council for the selection of representatives from Civil Society Organizations (CSOs) to the national and local DRRM Councils.

Section 5. Meetings and Quorum.

The meetings of the MCDRRMC shall be held once every three (3) months on the date and place to be determined by the body. The chairperson of the MCDRRMC may call for a special meeting, if warranted.

Section 6. Secretariat.

The Department of Disaster Resilience and Management (DDRM) shall serve as the Secretariat and executive arm of the MCDRRMC. The Secretariat shall be responsible for issuance of Notices of Meeting; logistical support for meetings; writing down, dissemination and recording of Minutes of Meeting; liaison with concerned individuals and groups, whether from the private or public sector; handling of administrative matters; among others.

Section 7. Technical Working Group.

The Technical Working Group (TWG, for brevity) of the MCDRRMC is hereby re-created, and it shall be composed of the following individuals, namely:

Section 8. Functions of the TWG.

The TWG of the MCDRRMC shall perform the following functions, namely:

(a) Organize technical meetings of the Council and the Council TWG;

(b) Generate Programs, Projects and Activities (PPA's) that are aligned with the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMF);

(c) Establish procedures and indicators, and assess, monitor and evaluate accomplishment results of PPAs in the utilization of the LDRRMF;

(d) Assist in the implementation of the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan;

(e) Serve as technical resource persons of the MCDRRMC; and

(f) Perform such other functions as may be directed by competent authority, or as may be necessary to accomplish the foregoing.

Section 9. Funding.

All costs pertaining to the operations of the MCDRRMC, including the payment of honoraria, incidental and other expenses to its members, and other appropriate personnel, as may hereinafter be identified by the Chairperson, shall be taken from the 5% Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund (LDRRMF), subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Section 10.

Allowance.

Subject to existing rules and regulations and availability of funds, proper documentation, reportorial requirement, and documentary attendance, each member of the MCDRRMC shall receive an allowance in the amount of Two Thousand (Php 2,000.00) Pesos for every meeting duly attended, *Provided, however*, there will be no more than two (2) meetings for every quarter.

Each member of the TWG shall receive an allowance in the amount of One Thousand (Php 1,000.00) Pesos for every meeting attended, *Provided, however*, there will be no more than three (3) meetings for every quarter.

Section 11. Repealing Clause.

All previously issued orders inconsistent with any provision found herein shall be deemed repealed, revoked, or amended accordingly.

Section 12. Separability Clause.

In case any provision found herein shall be judicially decided illegal or administratively declared infirm, untouched provisions shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 13. Effectivity Clause.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its signing, and it shall remain in full force and effect until repealed, revoked, or amended accordingly,
