EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 35
Series of 2022-B

**PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENTS TO EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 21, SERIES OF 2019,
EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 19, SERIES OF 2016,
EXECUTIVE ORDER NOS. 3 AND 3-A, SERIES OF 2014,
ON THE REORGANIZATION OF THE PEOPLE'S LAW ENFORCEMENT BOARD,
ITS COMPOSITION AND FUNCTIONS**

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Republic Act No. 6975, otherwise known as An Act Establishing the Philippine National Police under a Recognized Department of the Interior Local Government, and for Other Purposes, provides that *"(i)t is hereby declared to be the policy of the State to promote peace and order, ensure public safety and further strengthen local government capability aims towards the effective delivery of the basic services to the citizenry through the establishment of highly efficient and component police force that is national in scope and civilian in character. Towards this end, the State shall bolster a system of coordination and cooperation among the citizenry, local executives and the integrated law enforcement and public safety agencies created under this Act;"*

WHEREAS, the same statute provides for every city and municipality to create and establish a People's Law Enforcement Board (PLEB, *for brevity*), which shall be the central receiving entity for any complaint emanating from a citizen against officers and members of the Philippine National Police (PNP, *for brevity*); and, subject to the provisions of Section 41, *supra*, the PLEB shall take cognizance of or refer the complaint to the proper disciplinary or adjudicatory authority within three (3) days upon filing of the complaint;

WHEREAS, recent changes in election of officials and movements in personnel and the expiration of the term of members of the PLEB necessitate the introduction of amendments to Executive Order No. 21, Series of 2019, which provided amendments to Executive Orders No. 19, Series of No. 2016 and Nos. 3 and 3-A, Series of 2014, respectively;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rozzano Rufino B. Biazon, City Mayor of Muntinlupa, by virtue of the of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order and decree that;

Section 1. Reorganization of the People's Law Enforcement Board.

The People's Law Enforcement Board (PLEB, *for brevity*) of the City of Muntinlupa is hereby reorganized, and it shall be composed, henceforth, of the following individuals, namely:

pursuant to SP Resolution No. 2022-010, Series of 2022;

Duly designated to represent the Liga ng mga Barangay
pursuant to Liga Resolution No. 2018-001, Series of 2018;
- c. Atty. Victor C. Lizardo,
Member of the Philippine Bar;
- d. L/Col. Estrella N. Tabuco (Ret.)
Member of the Female Sex, and Former Naval Officer; and
- e. J/Col. Demetrio A. Alvarez
Former Bureau of Jail Management and Penology Officer.

Upon the issuance of this Executive Order, the members of the PLEB shall convene and decide on the designation of Chairperson and other essential positions among themselves. The outcome shall be reduced into writing, and it shall form an integral part of this Executive Order.

Section 2. Secretariat.

The Secretariat of the PLEB is likewise reorganized, and it shall be composed of the following individuals, with their respective designations, namely:

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The individuals from letters d to i form part of the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), Muntinlupa Field Operations Office.

The functions of the Secretariat include the preparation and issuance of Notice of Meeting; provision of logistical support to the conduct of any meeting and/or hearing; recording and transcribing of the Minutes of Meeting and/or Hearing; preparation, receipt and dissemination of correspondences and other related documents; and, preparation and submission of monthly status of PLEB Cases to the NAPOLCOM-NCR, the DILG-NCR and the PNP-Muntinlupa.

Section 3. Honorarium.

Pursuant to the seventh Whereas Clause of City Resolution No. 14-053, and for every meeting duly attended, the Chairperson of the PLEB shall receive the amount of Three Thousand (Php 3,000.00) Pesos, and for each member thereof the amount of Two Thousand Five Hundred (Php 2,500.00) Pesos.

Moreover, pursuant to the ninth Whereas Clause, *supra*, for the four (4) meetings duly facilitated and attended every month, the members of the Board and the Secretariat shall receive the following amounts, namely:

a.	Head.....	Php 12,000.00;
b.	PLEB Members.....	10,000.00;
c.	Investigator.....	7,000.00;
d.	NAPOLCOM Representative.....	6,000.00;
e.	Transcriber.....	5,000.00;
f.	Typist.....	5,000.00;
g.	Utility.....	4,000.00;
h.	Process Server.....	3,000.00;
i.	Driver.....	3,000.00.

Section 4. Repealing Clause.

All orders and similar directives inconsistent with any provision hereof shall be deemed revoked, rescinded, or amended accordingly.

Section 5. Separability Clause.

In the event any provision found herein shall be judicially decided illegal or administratively declared infirm, untouched provisions shall remain in full force and effect.



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


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Section 6. Effectivity Clause.
