**EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 39**  
**Series of 2022-B**

**PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE LOCAL INVESTMENT PLAN FOR HEALTH  
AND THE ANNUAL OPERATIONAL PLAN AS THE STRATEGIC INVESTMENT PLANS OF  
THE HEALTH SYSTEM OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF MUNTINLUPA,  
AND FOR THE CREATION OF ITS TEAM, COMPOSITION AND FUNCTIONS**

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**WHEREAS**, the Department of Health (DOH) introduced the Province-wide Investment Planning for Health (PIPH) in 2006 to strengthen the local health planning in sixteen (16) pilot convergence provinces. The strategy of investment planning was expanded to all Provinces in 2008 and 2009, and then to highly urbanized cities and independent component cities in 2009. The City-wide Investment Plans for Health (CIPH) was developed in all cities, forging a DOH-LGU partnership with a 5-year Memorandum of Agreement (MOA);

**WHEREAS**, the CIPH has been institutionalized and is renamed the Local Investment Plan for Health (LIPH). The time frame for the LIPH has been changed to three (3) years, coinciding with the three- year term of City Mayors;

**WHEREAS**, the LIPH is a 3-year planning cycle that is applied to a city and is a medium-term public plan for health;

**WHEREAS**, according to DOH Administrative Order No. 2020-022, 21 May 2020, entitled "Guidelines on the Development of Local Investment Plan for Health," the LIPH shall be anchored on the Universal Health Care principles of integrated and comprehensive approach to health, comprehensive health services, and people-oriented approach on needs and well-being;

**WHEREAS**, the Annual Operational Plan (AOP) refers to the yearly translation of the LIPH, which details the programs, plans and activities (PPAs) thereof;

**WHEREAS**, Section 22.3 the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 11223, otherwise known as the Universal Health Care (UHC) Act states that "(t)he province-wide and city-wide investment plans for health, also known as the LIPH, and the Annual Operational Plans (AOP) shall serve as the basis for the grants from the national government, to account for complementation of public and private health care providers and public or private health sector investments to national investment plans;"



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**WHEREAS**, DOH Memorandum No. 2021-0434, dated 11 October 2022, set the Directions for the Development of the 2023-2025 Local Investment Plans for Health and the 2023 Annual Operational Plans. It shall include the strategies to be undertaken to fully support the objective and goals of Executive Order No. 138, entitled "Full Devolution of Certain Functions of the Executive Branch of Local Governments, Creation of a Committee on Devolution, and for Other Purposes," issued by the Malacañang Palace, dated 01 June 2021, which provides for the full devolution of health services and functions;

**WHEREAS**, the City Health Office (CHO) of Muntinlupa shall spearhead the drafting and approval of the LIPH and AOP for the health-related programs, strategies, logistics, and activities of the Local Government Unit;

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rozzano Rufino B. Biazon, City Mayor of Muntinlupa**, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order and decree that:

Section 1. Adoption.

The Local Investment Plan for Health (LIPH, for brevity), and the Annual Operation Plan (AOP) as the Strategic Investment Plans of the Health System of the City Government of Muntinlupa (CGM) are hereby adopted and made integral parts of the overall development plans thereof.

Section 2. Creation of Team.

Local Investment Plan for Health and Annual Operation Plan Team.

The LIPH and AOP Team is hereby created, and it shall be composed of the following individuals, with their respective designations, namely:

Membership in the LIPH and AOP Team is a function, among officers and staff members of the City Government, of their respective offices. In the event, therefore, of their respective resignation, removal, transfer, termination, grave illness, severe incapacity, death, or any other similarly-situated circumstance, the successor thereof shall assume membership thereto without need for the issuance of another instrument.

Among those from the private sector, however, they shall still be measured by the same token of fidelity, accountability and integrity, and shall be replaced in any of the above-cited circumstances. The City Mayor shall choose the successor from a list of names to be submitted by the remaining members of the LIPH Team.

Section 2. Functions.

The LIPH Team and the AOP Team shall perform the following functions, namely:

- (a) Follow the planning process through the collection of needed health data and indices, conduct situational analyses, identify gaps, actions, logistics and strategies, and to identify the costs and fund sources; and incorporate in the plans the inputs from the Department of Health (DOH), the City Government of Muntinlupa (CGM), the respective Barangay Governments, and other stakeholders;
- (b) Prepare the LIPH and AOP Narratives using the prescribed AOP Forms;
- (c) Submit the LIPH and AOP to the DOH for appraisal;
- (d) Assimilate the comments of the DOH appraisal and recommendations, if any, in the editing of the final and substantively complete LIPH and AOP;
- (e) Endorse the approved LIPH and AOP to the Local Health Board;
- (f) Monitor and evaluate the LIPH and AOP implementation; and



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- (g) Perform such other functions that may be necessary in order to achieve the foregoing, or as may be directed by the City Mayor.

Section 3. Meetings and Quorum.

The LIPH and AOP Team shall meet at least once every three (3) months, or as may be necessary. A majority of the members shall constitute a quorum, and an affirmative vote of the majority shall be required for the approval of any proposal.

Section 4. Repealing Clause.

Any order inconsistent with any provision found herein shall be deemed repealed, revoked, or amended accordingly.


Section 5. Separability Clause.

In the event any provision found herein shall be judicially decided illegal or administratively declared infirm, untouched provisions shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 6. Effectivity Clause.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its signing, and it shall remain in full force and effect until repealed, revoked, or amended accordingly.
