**EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 48**  
Series of 2022-B

**PROVIDING FOR THE REVOCATION OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 15, SERIES OF 2020, ENTITLED PROVIDING FOR THE RESUMPTION OF TRICYCLE OPERATIONS IN THE CITY OF MUNTINLUPA IN THE PERIOD OF MODIFIED ENHANCED COMMUNITY QUARANTINE, FOR GUIDELINES AND LIMITATIONS THEREOF, AND PENALTIES**

**WHEREAS**, Executive Order No. 15, Series of 2020, issued on 20 May 2020, provided for the resumption of tricycle operations in the City of Muntinlupa during the period of Modified Enhanced Community Quarantine (MECQ), subject to restrictions, such as

- (a) Tricycle operation shall only be allowed from 5 o'clock in the morning to 12 o'clock midnight;
- (b) Odd-Even Coding Scheme among tricycle operators and drivers shall be implemented;
- (c) Sunday operations shall be disallowed;
- (d) The Tricycle Regulatory Unit (TRU) shall issue color-coded stickers, i.e., blue for those ending in odd digits, and yellow for even digits;

**WHEREAS**, the Federation of Muntinlupa Tricycle Operators and Drivers Association (FEDMUNTODA) wrote a letter to City Mayor Rozzano Rufino B. Biazon requesting for the revocation of Executive Order No. 15, Series of 2020, citing, as primary reasons therefor, the need to increase their daily income because:

- (a) They are allowed to operate only three (3) to four (4) times a week;
- (b) Fuel and spare parts cost have considerably increased;
- (c) With the opening of classes, passenger demand has increased; and
- (d) Transition to normalcy, i.e., life before the pandemic, has slowly taken hold;

**WHEREAS**, in a public hearing conducted by the Committee on Transportation of the Sangguniang Panlungsod, with Chairperson Ting Niefes presiding, on 14 September 2022, with the Muntinlupa Traffic Management Bureau (MTMB) and FEDMUNTODA in attendance, the latter was tasked to submit its Position Paper on or before 19 September 2022, extended to 03 October 2022;

**WHEREAS**, only sixteen (16) out of the thirty (30) Tricycle Operators and Drivers Associations (TODA) have complied thereto;

**WHEREAS**, the MTMB found merit in the Position Papers submitted, and, in a letter addressed to City Mayor Biazon, dated 05 October 2022, it wrote "*since we are transitioning back to normal situation from the previous effects of the pandemic, we believe that the executive order (sic) has served its purpose therefore recommending to lift the implementation of the Odd/Even Scheme;*"

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rozzano Rufino B. Biazon, City Mayor of Muntinlupa**, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order and decree that:

Section 1. Revocation.

Executive Order No. 15, Series of 2020, which provides for the Odd-Even Scheme for Tricycle Operators and Drivers in the City of Muntinlupa, is hereby revoked.


Section 2. Repealing Clause.

All orders and directives inconsistent with any provision contained herein shall be deemed repealed, revoked, or amended accordingly.

Section 3. Effectivity Clause.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its signing, and it shall remain in full force and effect until repealed, revoked, or amended accordingly.
