EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 51 Series of 2022-B

PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENTS TO EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 17, SERIES OF 2013,
EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 7, SERIES OF 2016,
AND EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 33, SERIES OF 2019,
ON THE REORGANIZATION AND RECOMPOSITION OF THE
LOCAL HEALTH BOARD OF THE CITY OF MUNTINLUPA,
ITS COMPOSITION AND FUNCTIONS

WHEREAS, Section 5, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution provides that "(t)he maintenance of peace and order, the protection of life, liberty, and property and the promotion of the general welfare are essential for the enjoyment by all the people of the blessings of democracy;"

WHEREAS, Section 17 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the 1991 Local Government Code, mandated for the devolution of the delivery of the health services and facilities as one of the basic functions and responsibilities of all the local government units at all level;

WHEREAS, Sec. 102, supra, provides that "(t)here shall be established a local board in every province city, or municipality;"

NOW, THEREFORE, *I, Rozzano Rufino B. Biazon, City Mayor of Muntinlupa*, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order and decree that:

Section 1. Reorganization and Re-composition.

The Local Health Board (*LHB*, *for brevity*) of the City of Muntinlupa is hereby reorganized with the following individuals, with their respective designations, namely:

Section 2.

Functions.

The LHB shall perform the following functions, namely:

- a. Propose to the Sanggunian Panlungsod, in accordance with the standards and criteria set by the Department of Health, annual budgetary allocations for the operations and maintenance of health services within the city;
- b. Serve as advisory committee to the Sanggunian Panlungsod on health matters such as, but not limited to, the necessity for, and application of, local appropriation for public health purposes; and
- c. Consistent with the technical and administrative standards of DOH, create committees which shall advise local health agencies on matters such as, but not limited to, personnel selection and promotion, bid and awards, grievance and complaints, personnel discipline, budget review, operations review, and similar functions.

Section 3. Meetings and Quorum.

The LHB shall meet at least a month, or as often as necessary. A majority of the members of the board shall constitute a quorum, but the Chairperson or Vice Chairperson must be present during meetings where budgetary proposals are being prepared or considered. The affirmative vote of all majority members shall be necessary to approve such proposals.

Section 4. Compensation and Remunerations.

The Chairperson, Vice Chairperson, and Members of the LHB shall perform their duties as such without compensation or remuneration. Members thereof who are not government officials or employees shall be entitled to necessary travelling expenses and allowance

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chargeable against the LHB fund, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Section 5. Direct National Supervision and Control by the Secretary of Health.

In case of epidemics, pestilence, and other widespread public health dangers, the Secretary of Health may, upon the direction of the President and in consultation with the City Government of Muntinlupa (CGM, for brevity), temporarily assume direct supervision and control over health operations for the duration of the emergency, but in no case to exceed an accumulative period of six (6) months. With the concurrence of the CGM, the period for such direct national control and supervision may be further extended.

Section 6. Repealing Clause.

All orders and directives issued in the past inconsistent with any provision herein found shall be considered repealed, revoked or amended accordingly.

Section 7. Separability Clause.

Should any provision herein found be judicially decided illegal or administratively declared infirm, untouched provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 8. Effectivity Clause.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately, and it shall remain in full force and effect until subsequently repealed, revoked or amended accordingly.
