**WHEREAS**, by virtue of **Resolution No. 91-191 and 91-192**, enacted on May 29, 1991, the then Sangguniang Bayan of Muntinlupa created and established the Muntinlupa Polytechnic College (MPC);

**WHEREAS**, the newly-established tertiary school of learning was initially housed at one of the school buildings at **Pedro E. Diaz High School**, in Alabang with an initial population of 309 students only;

**WHEREAS**, with the increasing number of enrollees, Muntinlupa Polytechnic College transferred to its second home at the Second Floor of Contessa Building , in Poblacion where all the offices and classrooms were air-conditioned and it was at this time that Muntinlupa Polytechnic College was placed under the supervision and jurisdiction of the Commission on Higher Education;

**WHEREAS**, emboldened by the fast growing student population, the need for expansion, a bigger campus and better facilities, a new school site with a new school building was permanently established inside the New Bilibid Prisons Reservation Area;

**WHEREAS**, Muntinlupa Polytechnic College is a city government supported institution of learning committed to the pursuit of excellence in the field of education;

**WHEREAS**, the vision of the Muntinlupa Polytechnic College is to establish "a world class learning center under the guidance of the Divine Providence that molds the attitude and values of the learner to transform our environment in the attainment of a more humane, compassionate and caring society to uplift the quality of life of the Filipino people";

**WHEREAS**, its mission is to “pursue excellence through an efficient and effective leadership and the exercise of democratic principles by providing state of the art technology courses, developing world class teaching methodologies and producing employable and highly productive graduates”;

**WHEREAS**, the Muntinlupa Polytechnic College now offers the following courses: Bachelor in Secondary Education, Bachelor in Elementary Education, Bachelor of Science in Commerce, Bachelor of Science in Computer Science, Bachelor of Science in Criminology and Associate in Computer Technology;

**WHEREAS**, in order to realize its vision and mission, it is imperative that Muntinlupa Polytechnic College secures all the assistance it can get not only from the City Government but also from the National Government;

**WHEREAS**, in order to secure financial subsidy from the national government, in order to further professionalize the **Muntinlupa Polytechnic College** as an institution of learning and in order to upgrade the quality of education, there is, therefore, a need to convert **Muntinlupa Polytechnic College** into a state college;


**WHEREAS**, when the Muntinlupa Polytechnic College is converted into a state college, its name shall be known as “**Muntinlupa City State College**”.


**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved as it is hereby resolved that a resolution be passed expressing the desire of the **City of Muntinlupa** for the conversion of the **Muntinlupa Polytechnic College** into a *state college*;

**RESOLVED, FURTHER**, that a copy of this resolution be immediately furnished to the **Honorable Congressman Ignacio R. Bunye, Representative Lone District of Muntinlupa** for his appropriate action and the **Department of Education Culture and Sports** and the **Commission on Higher Education**.

**ADOPTED**, by the *Sangguniang Panlungsod of Muntinlupa* this 27<sup>th</sup> day of **October 1999**, on its 59<sup>th</sup> Regular Session.


