AN ORDINANCE GRANTING THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION THIRTY THOUSAND PESOS (PHP1,030,000.00) OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO THE ONE HUNDRED FORTY-FOUR (144) FAMILIES AFFECTED BY FIRE ON FEBRUARY 24, 2023 AT NO. 44 UPPER SUCAT, BARANGAY SUCAT, MUNTINLUPA CITY

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 states that *“Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessarily appropriate, incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare”*:

WHEREAS, Section 458 (a)(1)(iv) of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that, *“The Sangguniang Panlungsod shall adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of the city from the harmful effects of man-made or natural disasters and calamities and provide relief services and assistance for victims during and in the aftermath of said disasters or calamities and their return to productive livelihood xxx”*;

WHEREAS, on *February 24, 2023 Sixty-Five (65) structures*, consisting of *One Hundred Forty-Four (144) families*, were gutted by fire at *No. 44 Upper Sucat, Barangay Sucat, Muntinlupa City*;

WHEREAS, in a final report rendered by the *Social Services Department* on *February 27, 2023*, the following were noted as casualties of the said fire:

1. *Sixty-Five (65) structures*;
2. *One Hundred Forty-Four (144) families*;
3. *Four Hundred Ninety-Four (494) individuals*;
4. *Sixteen (16) Senior Citizen*;
5. *Sixty-Seven (67) Children (0-5 years old)*;

WHEREAS, the **Social Service Department (SSD)** of the City of Muntinlupa and the **Barangay Chairman of Sucat**, conducted a survey on the victims of the fire to determine the homeowners, renters and sharers, basing the category of victims in accordance with prevailing ordinances, a recommendation on the matter that would entail a total amount of **One Million Thirty Thousand Pesos (Php1,030,000.00)** financial assistance to be distributed as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, AS IT HEREBY ORDAINED, by the **10th Sangguniang Panlungsod**, to grant the total amount of **One Million Thirty Thousand Pesos (Php1,030,000.00)** of financial assistance to the one hundred forty-four (144) families affected by fire on **February 24, 2023 at No. 44 Upper Sucat, Barangay Sucat, Muntinlupa City.**

FURTHER, that the **Final Disaster Report** dated **February 27, 2023 CN: 2023-005** issued by the **Social Services Department (SSD)** shall form part of this ordinance.

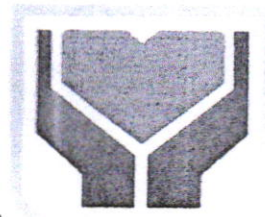

I. Assessment/Recommendation:

Based on the information gathered, **65 structures** were damaged during the fire incident affecting **144 families** or **494 individuals**. Designated Evacuation Camp are located in Barangay Sucat Multi-Purpose Covered Court and Sucat Elementary School while other affected families opted to stay near the fire site and some other lives with their relatives. Hot meals were already provided by the barangay, food and non-food relief were provided to the families from Barangay Sucat, City SSD, DSWD-NCR and other private agencies. It has been further assessed that based on the current condition of the affected families, they are qualified/eligible to avail financial assistance. Thus, the undersigned worker humbly recommends the affected families for financial assistance amounting to **One Million and Thirty Thousand Pesos (PHP1,030,000.00)** to augment in the repair/ other needs of family for their recovery.
