ON THE REORGANIZATION AND RECOMPOSITION OF
THE MUNTINLUPA CITY COUNCIL FOR THE PROTECTION OF CHILDREN,
AND ITS FUNCTIONS

WHEREAS, Section 13 of the Article II of the 1987 Constitution provides that "(t)he State recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation-building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social well-being. It shall inculcate in the youth patriotism and nationalism, and encourage their involvement in public and civic affairs;"

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 17-110 provides for the establishment of a New Local Council for the Protection of Children of Muntinlupa City and the creation of Inter-Agency Monitoring Task Force, thereby repealing City Ordinance No. 02-073;

WHEREAS, Section 3, supra, provides that "(t)he City Mayor, through an Executive Order (EO), may expand the Local Council for the Protection of Children (LCPC) composition if deemed necessary;"

WHEREAS, the task of child-friendly local governance and the vision of a child-caring city necessitates the evolution of the aforementioned Council towards an expanded composition of its members and a redefined organizational structure to better enforce its functions;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 29, Series of 2017, provided for the expansion of the composition and functions of the New Local Council for the Protection of Children of the City of Muntinlupa;

WHEREAS, the creation of a Local Early Childhood Care and Development Committee is duly mandated in accordance with Republic Act No. 10410, otherwise known as the Early Years Act, which shall institutionalize the National System for Early Childhood Care and Development (ECCD) involving the multi-sectoral and inter-agency collaboration at the national and local levels and promoting optimum growth and development of Filipino children from age zero to four;

WHEREAS, pursuant to a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) entered into between the City Government of Muntinlupa and the ECCD Council, the creation of the Muntinlupa City Local Early Childhood Care and Development Committee is indispensable, and it shall be a subcommittee of the Local Council for the Protection of Children to ensure sustainability of the program;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No.19, Series of 2019, provided for amendments to Executive Order No. 29 Series of 2017;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 46, Series of 2021, provided for amendments to Executive Order No. 19, Series of 2019;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 08, Series of 2022-B, provided for amendments to Executive Order No. 46, Series of 2021:

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 12, Series of 2023, provided for amendments to Executive Order No. 08, Series of 2022-B;

WHEREAS, further amendments need to be introduced and written;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rozzano Rufino B. Biazon, City Mayor of Muntinlupa, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order and decree that:

Section 2.

a. Devise plans and implement these into programs and policies of the Council, through the passage of a Resolution;

 Recommend, and, whenever necessary, submit policy directives to departments and offices of the City Government, through the issuance of a memorandum or order, duly signed by the City Mayor, for proper action;

 Enforce and implement the provisions contained in Section 5 of City Ordinance No. 17-110:

d. Conduct the regular meeting of the Executive Committee (Execom) once every two
 (2) months. The City Mayor, through the Co-Chairperson, may call for a special meeting, if necessary;

e. Conduct meetings per cluster to facilitate policy, plan and program formulation;

f. Perform such other functions as may be necessary to implement the foregoing, as may be directed by competent authority, or as may be provided for by law.

Section 3. Expansion of the Council.

Further to Section 2 of City Ordinance No. 17-110, the Composition of the Local Council for the Protection of Children (Council, *for brevity*) is expanded, and shall be broken into five (5) partitions, namely:

- (a) The Rights Clusters;
- (b) The Technical Management Committee;
- (c) The Inter-Agency Monitoring Task Force;
- (d) The Secretariat; and
- (e) The Local Early Childhood Care and Development Committee.

Section 3.E.2.

Functions.

The functions of the Local Early Childhood Care and Development Committee shall be as follows, namely:

- a. Ensure the integrated delivery of programs and services in the National Child Developme
- b. nt Center (NCDC), Child Development Centers (CDC), and Private Learning Centers (LCs);
- c. Provide support in the implementation of NCDC and CDC Improvement Plan;
- d. Support the implementation of the policies, plans, programs and projects developed by ECCD Council in the community;
- e. Resolve issues that may arise in the implementation of such programs and services;
- f. Promote awareness on ECCD through trainings, seminars, and campaigns;
- g. Documentation or data banking of related ECCD data and best practices for national and local policy formulation and monitoring of outcomes.

Section 4.

Succession.

Each member in any of the above-identified groupings assumes membership because of the office he or she occupies. As such, in the event of removal, resignation, termination, transfer, severe incapacity, grave illness, death, or any similarly-situated circumstance of an official, officer or employee above-named, the successor thereof shall assume membership in the vacant position, without need for the issuance of another instrument or order.

For members belonging to the private sector, his or her successor shall be named by the City Mayor from a list of individuals prepared and endorsed by the remaining members of the grouping, as the case may be.

Section 5.

Allowance.

Following Section 9 of Executive Order No. 29, Series of 2017, "permanent and expanded members of the Council shall be entitled to at least One Thousand (Php 1,000.00) Pesos allowance for every meeting attended, subject to the usual accounting and auditing laws, rules, and regulations."

Section 6.

Repealing Clause.

Any order or directive issued in the past inconsistent with any provision found herein shall be deemed repealed, revoked, or amended accordingly.

Section 7.

Separability Clause.

Any provision in this Executive Order judicially decided illegal or administratively declared infirm shall not affect untouched provisions, which shall continue to have full force and effect.

Section 8.

Effectivity Clause.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its signing, and it shall remain in full force and effect until repealed, revoked, or amended accordingly.
