PROVIDING FOR THE RE-ESTABLISHMENT AND RE-COMPOSITION OF THE
MUNTINLUPA BLOOD COUNCIL

WHEREAS, City Ordinance No. 01-007, enacted on 14 September 2001, provided for the establishment of the Muntinlupa Blood Council;

WHEREAS, the City of Muntinlupa, in recent years, has received recognition for its remarkable efforts to solicit blood donations and fortify its blood bank, as well as helping other agencies such as the Philippine National Red Cross, hospitals and other local government units (LGUs) in need of blood donations;

WHEREAS, as recent as 2019, the City of Muntinlupa was conferred the Jose Rizal Award (SANDUGO), the Gawad Bayanihan Award (SANDUGO) and the Best in National Voluntary Blood Services Program (Department of Health);

WHEREAS, the work of the Muntinlupa Blood Council (MBC) remains important and introducing new members to its composition will ensure its sustainability, relevance and essence in health programs of the City Government of Muntinlupa, particularly with regard to the City Health Office (CHO), as well as in the adequacy of blood supply;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rozzano Rufino B. Biazon, City Mayor of Muntinlupa, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order and decree that:

Section 1. Re-establishment and Re-composition.

The Muntinlupa Blood Council (MBC, for brevity) is hereby re-established, and it shall be re-composed of the following individuals, with their respective designations, namely:

Membership in the MBC, among public officials and officers, is a function of their respective offices. As such, the resignation, removal, transfer, termination, severe incapacity, grave illness, death, or any other similarly-situated circumstance shall entitle the successor to assume membership without need for the issuance of another order or instrument.

For those from the private sector, in any of the circumstances above-mentioned, the successor shall be named by the City Mayor from a list of names which the remaining members have prepared and duly submitted. They shall be measured by the same fidelity to transparency, accountability and integrity as their counterparts from the public sector.

Section 2. Functions.

The MBC shall perform the following functions, namely:

- (a) formulate and implement the blood program of the City of Muntinlupa, and promote and encourage voluntary blood donation among the citizens thereof;
- (b) strengthen the linkages among the blood service facilities and related institutions in accordance with zoning and affiliated procedures of concerned agencies and institutions;
- (c) disseminate information on the blood program of the City of Muntinlupa, increase awareness of the benefits of voluntary blood donation, and impress upon different communities of the city the needs of patients for safe blood donations;
- (d) select, recruit target groups and organize mass blood donations in communities;
- (e) monitor and evaluate the voluntary blood services program of the City Health Office;
- (f) study, draft, submit and recommend enactment of ordinances and passage of resolutions;
- (g) ensure adequate funding through close coordination with the blood program of the City Health Office, especially in the period covering budget deliberations and finalization, and engage in fund raising, should the opportunity present itself and subject to rules and regulations imposed by relevant government offices and agencies.

Section 3. Funding.

The City Health Office shall ensure funding of the blood program, including administrative matters concerning the Council, in its Annual Investment Plan (AIP).

Section 4. Meetings.

The Council shall decide on the frequency of its regular meetings. A special meeting, whenever warranted, may be called for.

Section 5. Repealing Clause.

All previous orders inconsistent with any provision found herein shall be deemed repealed, revoked, or amended accordingly.

Section 6. Separability Clause.

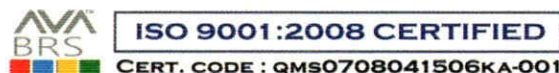
In the event any provision found herein shall be judicially decided illegal or administratively declared infirm, untouched provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
