EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 23
 Series of 2023

**PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF THE
 TASK FORCE TO OVERSEE AND PROTECT COMMUNITIES AND PROPERTIES,
 NOT COVERED BY EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 46, SERIES OF 2020 AND
 EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 01, SERIES OF 2019,
 AFFECTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION -
 PHILIPPINE NATIONAL RAILWAYS -
 NORTH TO SOUTH RAILWAY PROJECT
 (DOTr-PNR North-South Railway Project)**

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 46, Series of 2020, issued on 14 December 2020, which amended Executive Order No. 01, Series of 2019, provided for the creation of the Local Inter-Agency Committee (LIAC) for the Department of Transportation – Philippine National Railways – North to South Railway Project, which involves the rehabilitation and expansion of the railroad system between the Cities of Manila and Calamba, thereby affecting the City of Muntinlupa;

WHEREAS, the aforementioned Executive Orders dwell on the necessity of safeguarding the welfare of non-landowners that will be affected by the same project;

WHEREAS, in the same vein, communities with legal title to the land whereon their respective residences are built, and real properties owned and controlled by the City Government of Muntinlupa, such as, but not limited to, Muntinlupa Business High School in Barangay Buli, Orellana Compound in Barangay Putatan, and Pacwood in Barangay Tunasan, have to be overseen and protected;

WHEREAS, close coordination with the National Government Agencies, i.e., the Department of Transportation (DOTr) and the Philippine National Railways, has to be maintained in order to ensure the foregoing are enforced;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Muntinlupa recognizes the importance of an efficient and modern railway system as reliable means of transportation;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Muntinlupa supports the implementation of the DOTr-PNR North-South Commuter Railway Extension Project which will traverse the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Muntinlupa;





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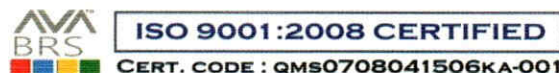
WHEREAS, in implementing the Road Right-of-Way of the PNR North-South Commuter Railway Extension Project traversing certain private and public lands, there are properties and families in communities in the City of Muntinlupa that will be affected;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rozzano Rufino B. Biazon, City Mayor of Muntinlupa, by virtue of the powers vested upon me by law, do hereby order and decree that:

Section 1. Creation and Composition.

The Task Force to Oversee and Protect Communities and Properties (Task Force, for brevity) affected by the Department of Transportation – Philippine National Railways – North to South Railway Project (DOTr-PNR North-South Railway Project) is hereby created, and it shall be composed of the following individuals, with their respective designations, namely:

Membership in the Task Force is a function of the office the member occupies. As such, the resignation, removal, transfer, termination, severe incapacity, grave illness, death, or any other similarly-situated circumstance of the members shall entitle the successor to assume membership without the need for the issuance of another order or instrument.

Section 2. Functions.

The Task Force shall perform the following functions, namely:

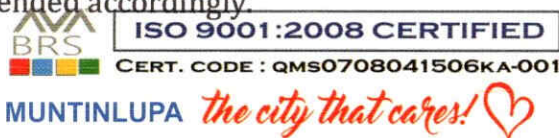
- Conduct an inventory of communities, not otherwise covered by Executive Order No. 46, Series of 2020, which amended Executive Order No. 01, Series of 2019, and properties owned and controlled by the City Government of Muntinlupa (CGM);
- Coordinate with the Department of Transportation (DOTr) and the Philippine National Railways (PNR) on the best possible resolution to conflicts and/or concerns that may arise between the interests of the railway project and the affected communities and CGM properties;
- Identify alternate roads for use in case the railway project limits the use of or imposes a closure order on existing roads, pathways, or easements;
- Recommend to the City Mayor the issuance of orders or the endorsement to the Sangguniang Panlungsod of possible legislation in order to resolve conflicts and/or concerns contemplated in paragraph (b).

Section 3. Meetings.

The Task Force, at its inception, shall decide on the frequency of its regular meetings. The Head may call for a special meeting, if warranted.

Section 4. Repealing Clause.

All previously issued orders inconsistent with any provision found herein shall be deemed repealed, revoked, or amended accordingly.



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Section 5. Separability Clause.

In the event any provision found herein shall be judicially decided illegal or administratively declared infirm, untouched provisions shall continue to have full force and effect.

Section 6. Effectivity Clause.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately upon its signing, and it shall remain in full force and effect until repealed, revoked, or amended accordingly.
