EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 42
Series of 2023

**PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF THE DRAINAGE MASTER PLAN
INTER-AGENCY TEAM OF THE CITY OF MUNTINLUPA,
ITS TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP AND SECRETARIAT,
AND THEIR RESPECTIVE COMPOSITION AND FUNCTIONS**

WHEREAS, Section 17 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, mandates local government units (LGUs) to provide basic services to its residents through construction of infrastructure facilities that include rainwater collectors, seawalls, dikes, drainage and sewerage systems, flood control systems, and similar facilities;

WHEREAS, the Writ of Continuing Mandamus of 2009 or G.R. No. 171947-48 issued by the Supreme Court mandates Thirteen (13) National Government Agencies (NGAs) and LGUs within the Manila Bay area to clean-up, rehabilitate, and preserve Manila Bay, and restore and maintain its water to Class SB level;

WHEREAS, in relation thereto, the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) has created the Manila Bay Clean-up, Rehabilitation, and Preservation Program (MBCRP) to keep track and assess the progress in the implementation of G.R. No. 171947-48 based on the compliance data submitted by each LGU in support to the rehabilitation of Manila Bay;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10121, otherwise known as the Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010, was passed to uphold the constitutional rights of the people to life and property by building the resilience of local communities to disasters including climate change impacts;

WHEREAS, City Ordinance 18-153, entitled *An Ordinance Enacting the Environmental Code of Muntinlupa City*, was signed to put into codal form the City of Muntinlupa's vision as a progressive community that has a peaceful and clean environment, and a community that places high value for the environment;

WHEREAS, the City Government of Muntinlupa has to comply with the foregoing as it strides to be a climate-change adaptive and disaster-resilient community through the

implementation of flood-control and drainage-relevant programs, projects, and activities (PPAs) for the City;

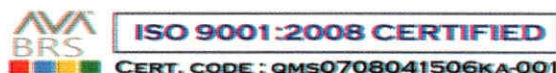
WHEREAS, the development, rehabilitation, improvement, construction, and maintenance of flood-control and drainage systems in the City of Muntinlupa need to be systematically planned and designed through the formulation of the City of Muntinlupa's Drainage Master Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rozzano Rufino B. Biazon, City Mayor of Muntinlupa, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order and decree that:

Section 1. Creation and Composition.

The Drainage Master Plan Inter-Agency Team (*DMP-IAT, for brevity*) of the City of Muntinlupa is hereby created, and it shall be composed of the following individuals, with their respective designations, namely:

Membership in the DMP-IAT is a function of the office each member occupies. As such, the resignation, removal, retirement, transfer, termination, severe incapacity, grave illness, death, or any other similarly-situated circumstance of the member shall entitle the successor thereof to assume membership without the need for the issuance of another order.

Section 2. Functions of the DMP-IAT.

The Muntinlupa City DMP-IATF shall perform the following functions, namely:

- (a) Conduct meetings to promptly address issues and concerns relating to flood-control and drainage systems;
- (b) Provide strategic direction in the formulation of the City of Muntinlupa's Drainage Master Plan;
- (c) Initiate review and consolidation of the workshop output as an integral part of the Drainage Master Plan;
- (d) Conduct periodic review, amendments, and revision of the Drainage Master Plan, complementing the City's growth and development;
- (e) Recommend to the City Mayor, through the City Development Council (CDC), the approval and adoption of the formulated City of Muntinlupa's Drainage Master Plan; and
- (f) Perform such other functions as may be necessary in the furtherance of the foregoing, or as may be directed by competent authority.

Section 3. Technical Working Group.

The Technical Working Group (*TWG, for brevity*) shall be composed of the following individuals, with their respective designations, namely:

Membership in the TWG is a function of the office each member occupies. As such, the resignation, removal, retirement, transfer, termination, severe incapacity, grave illness, death, or any other similarly-situated circumstance of the member shall entitle the successor thereof to assume membership without the need for the issuance of another order.

Section 4. Functions of the TWG.

The TWG shall perform the following functions, namely:

- (a) Initiate and coordinate the formulation of City of Muntinlupa Drainage Master Plan Drainage Master Plan;

- (b) Lay the groundwork for the formulation and development of the City of Muntinlupa Drainage Master Plan;
- (c) Gather data necessary for the formulation of the Drainage Master Plan;
- (d) Engage the services of technical consultant, whether individually or collectively, if warranted, and work on the administrative requirements thereof, such as, but not limited to, the allocation of funds for that purpose;
- (e) Conduct and evaluate the technical inventory and/or baseline survey on existing drainage systems in the City of Muntinlupa; and
- (f) Coordinate, collaborate, and consult with concerned City Government Department or Office and National Government Agencies.

Section 5. Secretariat.

Staff members of the City Planning and Development Office (CPDO) and the City Engineering Department (CED) shall act as the Secretariat of the DMP-IAT and the TWG. The Heads thereof shall appoint who among the staff members shall act as the Lead Secretary and members.

Section 6. Functions of the Secretariat.

The Secretariat shall perform the following functions, namely:

- (a) Facilitate inter-agency, inter-governmental, and field headquarters coordination, when warranted;
- (b) Consolidate and integrate all documents related to the formulation of the Muntinlupa City Drainage Master Plan;
- (c) Provide administrative and logistics support to the DMP-IAT and the TWG;
- (d) Undertake liaising and coordination meetings and activities as needed with appropriate agencies of the government; and
- (e) Perform such acts in order to accomplish the foregoing, or as may be directed by competent authority.

Section 7. Funds.

Funds necessary to carry out the provisions of this Order, such as, but not limited to, conduct of meetings, workshops, benchmarking or similarly-situated activities needed for the realization and effective implementation of the Drainage Master Plan shall be taken from the five percent (5%) of the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund under the General Fund of the City Government.

Section 8. Repealing Clause.

All orders or issuances inconsistent with the provisions of this Executive Order are hereby repealed, revoked, or amended accordingly.


Section 9. Separability Clause.

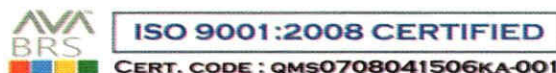
In the event that any provision found herein is judicially decided illegal or administratively declared infirm, untouched provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
